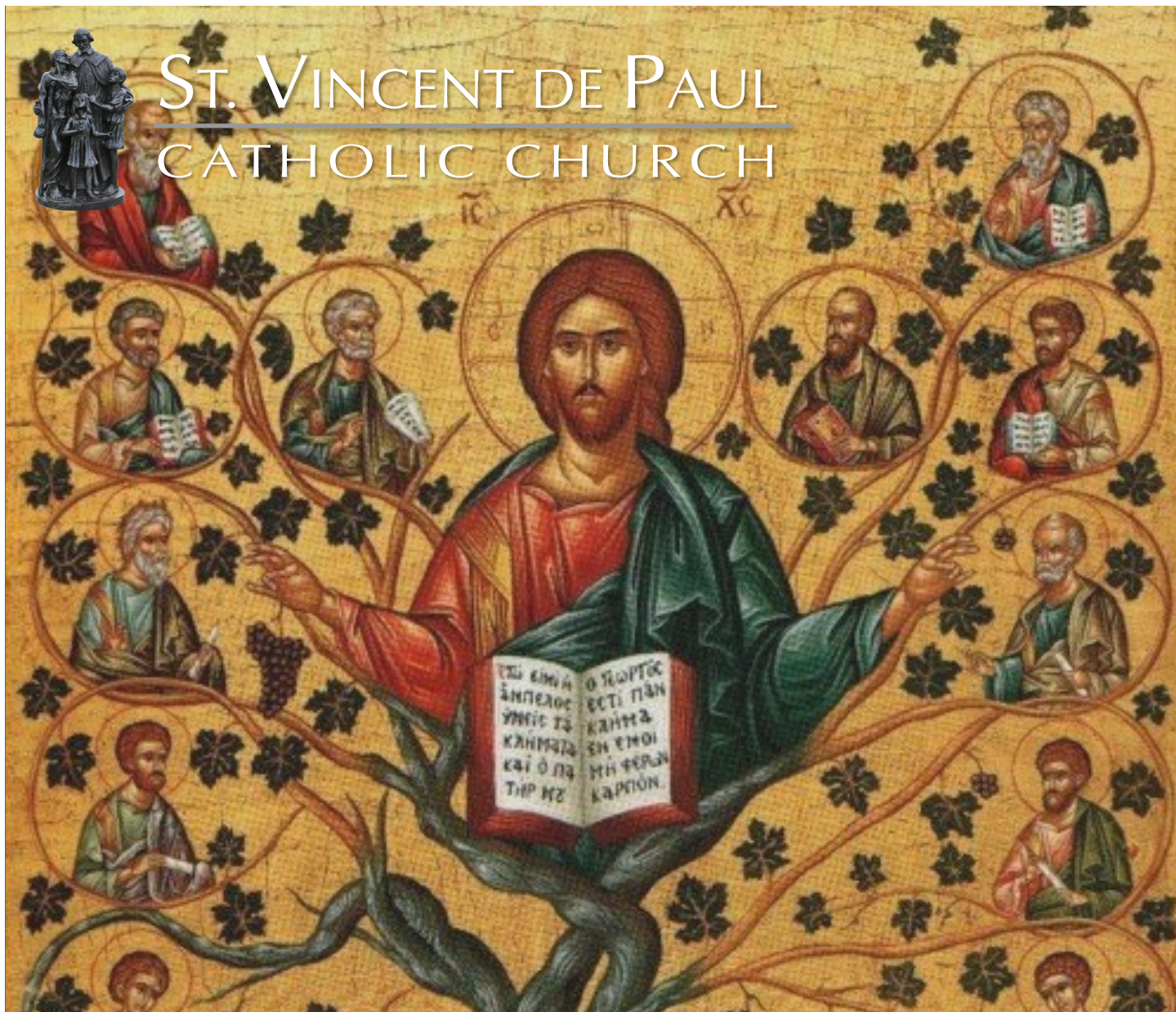

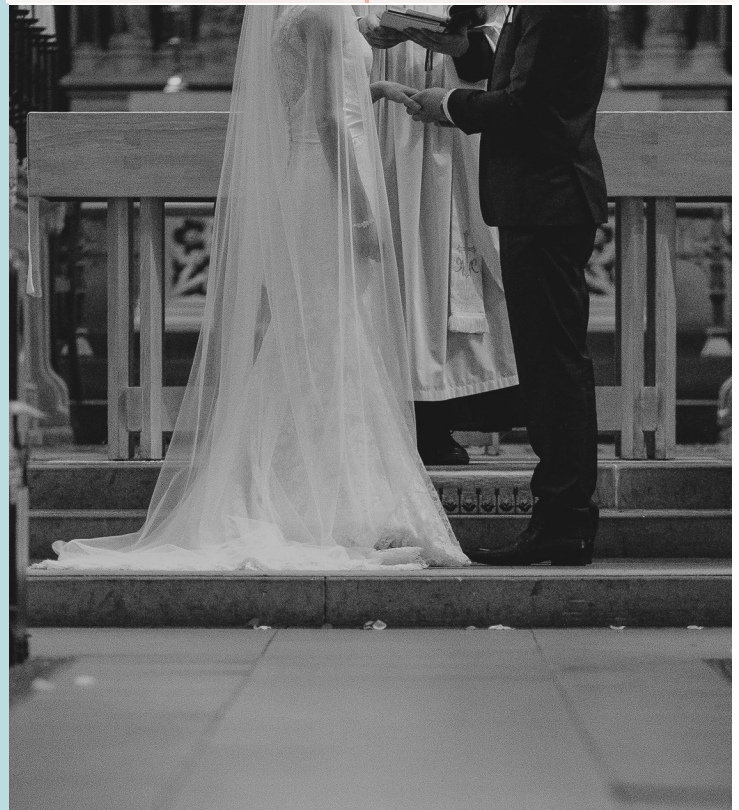

Pray the Rosary Marathon to end the pandemic

Pope Francis first appealed to Catholics worldwide to pray the rosary to end the COVID-19 pandemic in May 2020. In Catholic tradition, the month of May is dedicated to Mary. Now, as the virus rages on in places like India, he is asking the faithful again to dedicate the month of May to a "marathon of prayer," which "rises continuously from the entire Church to the Father" to end this global threat.

The theme: "Prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God" (Acts 12:5) refers to the faithful praying for Peter (Acts 12:1-12) who was "who was imprisoned until God sent an angel to free him, illustrating how the Christian community comes together to pray in the face of danger and how the Lord listens and performs an unexpected miracle" explained Catholic News Service.

The Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization organized this effort with the help of 30 Marian shrines worldwide "to reach priests, families and all the faithful, inviting them to join in this prayer of intercession and hope to the Blessed Virgin Mary."

Each day will focus on a different prayer intention of the various ways people have been affected by the pandemic. Examples include prayer "for those who have not been able to say goodbye to their loved ones, for all health care personnel, for the poor, the homeless, those in economic difficulty and for all the deceased."

Throughout May, there will be a livestream from one of the 30 chosen Marian shrines to lead the prayer at 6 p.m. Rome time (11 a.m. central time) on Vatican media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube). The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. will lead the rosary on May 17. Pope Francis will lead the first rosary on May 1 and conclude it on May 31.

Maratón Reza el Rosario para poner fin a la pandemia

El Papa Francisco hizo la primera petición a los Católicos de todo el mundo para que rezaran el rosario para poner fin a la pandemia de COVID-19 en mayo de 2020. En la tradición católica, el mes de mayo está dedicado a María. Ahora, mientras el virus avanza en lugares como India, pide nuevamente a los fieles que dediquen el mes de mayo a un "maratón de oración", que "sube continuamente de toda la Iglesia al Padre" para acabar con esta amenaza global.

El tema: "La oración de la Iglesia se hacía fervientemente a Dios" (Hechos 12: 5) se refiere a los fieles que oraban por Pedro (Hechos 12: 1-12) que era "quien estaba preso hasta que Dios envió un ángel para liberarlo, ilustrando cómo la comunidad Cristiana se une para orar frente al peligro y cómo el Señor escucha y realiza un milagro inesperado", explicó Catholic News Service.

El Consejo Pontifical para la Promoción de la Nueva Evangelización organizó este esfuerzo con la ayuda de 30 santuarios Marianos en todo el mundo "para llegar a los sacerdotes, las familias y todos los fieles, invitándolos a unirse en esta oración de intercesión y esperanza a la Santísima Virgen María".

Cada día se centrará en una intención de oración diferente de las diversas formas en que las personas se han visto afectadas por la pandemia. Los ejemplos incluyen la oración "por aquellos que no han podido despedirse de sus seres queridos, por todo el personal

sanitario, por los pobres, los desamparados, los que atraviesan dificultades económicas y todos los fallecidos".

A lo largo de mayo, habrá una transmisión en vivo de uno de los 30 santuarios marianos elegidos para dirigir la oración a las 6 p.m. Hora de Roma (11 a. M. Hora central) en las plataformas de medios del Vaticano (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube). La Basílica del Santuario Nacional de la Inmaculada Concepción en Washington, DC dirigirá el rosario el 17 de mayo. El Papa Francisco dirigirá el primer rosario el 1 de mayo y lo concluirá el 31 de mayo.

Reading I: Acts 9:26-31

Then Barnabas took charge of him and brought him to the apostles, and he reported to them how he had seen the Lord, and that he had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had spoken out boldly in the name of Jesus. He moved about freely with them in Jerusalem, and spoke out boldly in the name of the Lord. He also spoke and debated with the Hellenists, but they tried to kill him. And when the brothers learned of this, they took him down to Caesarea and sent him on his way to Tarsus.

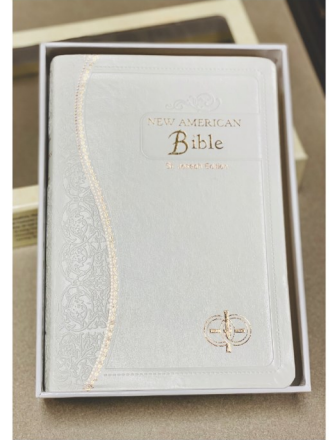
