

Lent and the gift of time...

For many, Lent brings sobering thoughts; fasting, abstaining, sacrificing come to mind; forty days without the comfort of a favorite meal or activity – the gray days of Lent. Maybe this period suffers by comparison to the happier anticipation of Christmas that Advent offers, but Lent prepares us for the peak celebration of the liturgical calendar, Easter, honoring the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Originally Lent was a period of preparation for the Order of Catechumens as they concluded as much as a three-year journey of conversion to the mind, heart and will of Christ. Today the catechumenate (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) takes much less time, but its purpose is still to assist people in their search for God in the Catholic Church.

What about the rest of us? What does Lent have to do with those who are Catholic Christians already? We can look upon the 40 Days as a retreat during which we focus on God's mercy as it relates to our own sinfulness as individuals, as a church and as a society. In doing this we show our unity with those who are preparing to join the Church at Easter.

What else? "Giving up something for Lent" is a good disciplinary practice as far as it goes; but what is the purpose of such self-denial? I'd like to propose making a stronger resolution this Lent: let's resolve to grow closer to God and his Son Jesus. This takes time and effort, so try to give up something that at present takes away time from your relationship with the Lord, such as TV or time on the internet that could be used more productively. Resolve to watch less TV and spend less time on the internet and use the time saved to read a good spiritual book or to pray with scripture. Watching one less 30-minute program in the evening can mean 30 more minutes of time with God. Giving up desserts is a good way to lose some weight. Spending more time with the Lord is a good way to gain more of the joy of loving the One who loves us.



La cuaresma y el regalo del tiempo...

Para muchos, la Cuaresma trae pensamientos aleccionadores; ayunar, abstenerse, sacrificar vienen a la mente; cuarenta días sin la comodidad de una comida o actividad favorita: los días grises de la Cuaresma. Tal vez este período sufre en comparación con la anticipación más feliz de la Navidad que ofrece el Adviento, pero la Cuaresma nos prepara para la celebración máxima del calendario litúrgico, la Pascua, en honor a la Resurrección de Jesucristo. Originalmente, la Cuaresma fue un período de preparación para la Orden de los Catecúmenos, ya que concluyeron tanto como un viaje de conversión de tres años a la mente, el corazón y la voluntad de Cristo. Hoy el catecumenado (Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos) lleva mucho menos tiempo, pero su propósito es ayudar a las personas en su búsqueda de Dios en la Iglesia Católica.

¿Qué pasa con el resto de nosotros? ¿Qué tiene que ver la Cuaresma con aquellos que ya son cristianos católicos? Podemos considerar los 40 días como un retiro durante el cual nos enfocamos en la misericordia de Dios en lo que respecta a nuestra propia pecaminosidad como individuos, como iglesia y como sociedad. Al hacer esto, mostramos nuestra unidad con aquellos que se están preparando para unirse a la Iglesia en la Pascua.

¿Qué más? "Renunciar a algo para la Cuaresma" es una buena práctica disciplinaria hasta donde llega; ¿Pero cuál es el propósito de tal abnegación? Me gustaría proponer una resolución más fuerte en esta Cuaresma: resolvamos acercarnos a Dios y a su Hijo Jesús. Esto lleva tiempo y esfuerzo, así que trate de renunciar a algo que actualmente le quita tiempo a su relación con el Señor, como la televisión o el tiempo en Internet que podría usarse de manera más productiva. Resuelva mirar menos televisión y pasar menos tiempo en Internet y usar el tiempo ahorrado para leer un buen libro espiritual o rezar con las Escrituras. Mirar un programa de 30 minutos menos por la noche puede significar 30 minutos más de tiempo con Dios. Renunciar a los postres es una buena manera de perder peso. Pasar más tiempo con el Señor es una buena manera de obtener más alegría de amar a Aquel que nos ama.
