Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back at least to the 11th century, but through the 16th century, it remained a private devotion, often tied to devotion to the Five Wounds of Christ.

About the Feast of the Sacred Heart According to the Gospel of John (19:33), when Jesus was dying on the cross "one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water." The celebration of the Sacred Heart is associated with the physical wound (and the associated sacrifice), the "mystery" of both blood and water pouring from Christ's chest, and the devotion God asks from humankind.

Pope Pius XII wrote about the Sacred Heart in his 1956 encyclical, *Haurietis Aquas* (On Devotion To The Sacred Heart): *Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is devotion to Jesus Christ Himself, but in the particular ways of meditating on his interior life and on His threefold love: His divine love, His burning love that fed His human will, and His sensible love that affects His interior life.*

History of the Feast of the Sacred Heart The first feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated on August 31, 1670, in Rennes, France, through the efforts of Fr. Jean Eudes (1602-1680). From Rennes, the devotion spread, but it took the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) for the devotion to become universal.

In all of these visions, in which Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary, the Sacred Heart of Jesus played a central role. The "great apparition," which took place on June 16, 1675, during the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, is the source of the modern Feast of the Sacred Heart. In that vision, Christ asked St. Margaret Mary to request that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the octave (or eighth day) of the Feast of Corpus Christi, in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice that Christ had made for them. The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents not simply His physical heart but His love for all mankind.

Please join us as we celebrate the Feast of the Sacred Heart on Friday, June 28th at the 8:00 am English Mass. A Pot-Luck brunch will be held after Mass. In addition, please join us in the Adoration Chapel on Friday evening from 10:00pm to 2:00 am as we gather to say the rosary and honor the Mediatrix, the Immaculate Heart of Mary, intercessor for our prayer requests to her Son, Jesus.



La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús se remonta al menos al siglo XI, pero a lo largo del siglo XVI, siguió siendo una devoción privada, a menudo vinculada a la devoción a las Cinco Heridas de Cristo.

Acerca de la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón. De acuerdo con el Evangelio de Juan (19:33), cuando Jesús estaba muriendo en la cruz, "uno de los soldados le perforó el costado con una lanza, y de inmediato salió sangre y agua". La celebración del Sagrado Corazón está asociada con la herida física (y el sacrificio asociado), el "misterio" de la sangre y el agua que brota del pecho de Cristo, y la devoción que Dios le pide a la humanidad.

El Papa Pío XII escribió sobre el Sagrado Corazón en su encíclica de 1956, *Haurietis Aquas* (Sobre la devoción al Sagrado Corazón): *La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús es la devoción a Jesucristo mismo, pero en las formas particulares de meditar en su vida interior y en su triple amor: su amor divino, su amor ardiente que alimentó su voluntad humana y su amor sensible que afecta su vida interior.*

Historia de la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón La primera fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se celebró el 31 de agosto de 1670 en Rennes, Francia, a través de los esfuerzos del Padre Jean Eudes (1602-1680). Desde Rennes, la devoción se extendió, pero tomó las visiones de Santa Margarita María Alacoque (1647-1690) para que la devoción se convirtiera en universal.

En todas estas visiones, en las que Jesús se apareció a Santa Margarita María, el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús jugó un papel central. La "gran aparición", que tuvo lugar el 16 de junio de 1675, durante la octava de la fiesta de Corpus Christi, es la fuente de la fiesta moderna del Sagrado Corazón. En esa visión, Cristo le pidió a Santa Margarita María que solicitara que la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se celebrara el viernes después de la octava (u octavo día) de la Fiesta de Corpus Christi, en reparación por la ingratitud de los hombres por el sacrificio que Cristo había hecho para ellos. El Sagrado Corazón de Jesús no representa simplemente su corazón físico sino su amor por toda la humanidad.

Únase a nosotros mientras celebramos la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón el viernes 28 de junio en la misa en inglés a las 8:00 am. Después de la misa se llevará a cabo un brunch a la canasta. Además, únase a nosotros en la Capilla de la Adoración el viernes por la noche de 10:00 pm a 2:00 am mientras nos reunimos para rezar el rosario y honrar a la Mediadora, el Corazón Inmaculado de María, intercesora de nuestras peticiones de oración a su Hijo, Jesús.

Has Jesus Been Calling You to Spend Time With Him?

For any relationship to thrive, continue to grow, and deepen, we must share ourselves through time spent together and through conversation. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Vincent de Paul is your opportunity, on a daily basis, to be with Jesus. He invites you to spend time with him. He waits for you in the church, and looks forward to spending time with you. He waits to hear all you have to tell him, and all that you have to ask of him. He waits for you to open your heart to hear what he has to say to you.

An hour in adoration is your personal time with Jesus to cultivate a true relationship with Him. Sit quietly, or have a silent heart to heart conversation – Be present to Jesus as He is Present to you. Adore him – show him love and Gratitude. Consider his humility as he avails himself to you.

In adoration of the Blessed Sacrament we answer the call from the Lord to adore His Real Presence in the Eucharist. We join a line of people that stretches through the centuries, from the stable in Bethlehem in the company of the Angels, shepherds, and Magi – through all of history to this day. This mystical union of ages and adoring souls has sustained the very heart of the Church.

Adoration is the giving of your time to the Lord, and for such a commitment, graces and blessings will be bestowed on you and your loved ones – in this life and the next. Adoration will also strengthen our parish family, and help us to stay focused on the important events in our journey through life.

I am new to adoration and am finding it somewhat awkward to fill the hour without becoming distracted. What can I do to remain focused? To help regain your focus when you find your mind drifting away from your conversation with or contemplation of Jesus you can:

- ✦ Pray a rosary or Chaplet or the Liturgy of the Hours.
- ✦ Read and pray about Scripture or spiritual reading.
- ✦ Pray for: The intentions of the Pope, The Pope, The Church, Our Priests, our Parish, our Youth and Youth Programs, Vocations, The Right to Life, The Family - and any concerns you have.

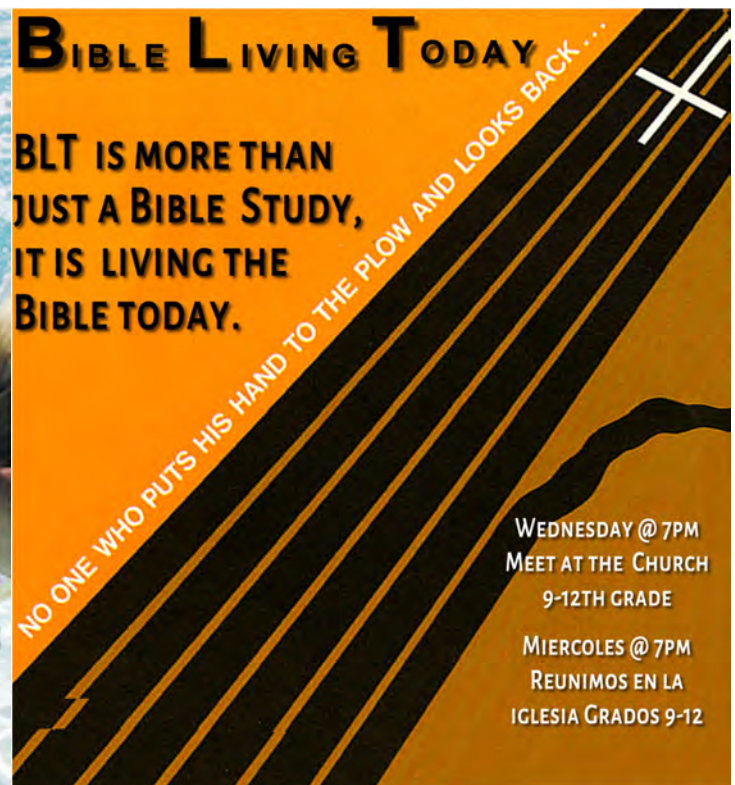

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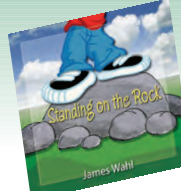
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
