Are you a “Martha” or “Mary”?

To me, there is nothing quite like throwing a good dinner party. I cannot wait to get out the best dishes, our eclectic mix of serving bowls, the dusty bread basket, utensil caddy, and cloth napkins and placemats. I can get out the cake server and whip up a favorite dessert. I get to put out my best for our guests! No doubt about it: I’m a “Martha.” Hospitality is my thing. With little kids at home, we don’t use the “nice stuff” very often so when we I do have an opportunity to pull these things out, I am all over it.

Then, in the midst of all the cleaning and setting up, I get grumbly. I want others to help me, but I also fuss over how they put things out

because it’s not how I imagined it would look. I am so busy trying to make everything look great that I fail to focus my attention on the guests who have just arrived. No doubt about it: I’m still a “Martha.”

In today’s Gospel, we hear how Martha “fussed” over the hospitality in her home at the expense of spending time with her guest, THE GUEST. The story of Martha and Mary isn’t so much about working vs. not working, serving vs. not serving. As a matter of fact, our work, our service is a very good thing! But, this Gospel reminds us that the Lord is always present and that whatever we do should serve him. The work that Martha was doing, her service to Jesus and his disciples, was good and necessary. What she lost sight of was Jesus: she took her eyes off the one who she was serving. Mary chose the better because her eyes remained upon Christ. We don’t have to stop working but we do need to remember for whom we are working.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that work is good: *“Work is both a duty and a right through which human beings collaborate with God the Creator. In work, the person exercises and fulfills in part the potential inscribed in his nature... Work is for man, not man for work”* (CCC 2427-2428).

St. John Paul II’s Theology of the Body tells us that work is good: *“More than what work we do, it’s how we do our work that matters.... [It’s] how we make every minute of our workday a silent witness to the God we love. When we do all that rightly, we make a gift of ourselves”* (from These Beautiful Bones by Emily Stimpson).

The Bible tells us that work is good: *“On the seventh day God completed the work he had been doing; he rested on the seventh day from all the work he had undertaken”* (Genesis 2:2) and *“Whatever you do, do from the heart, as for the Lord and not for others”* (Colossians 3:23).

Work is good. There is dignity in working. Our human nature calls us to work alongside the Creator in order to bring good into this world. It’s good to be a “Martha.” But I have learned that I must keep my eyes on the guest I serve, seeing Jesus in each soul that my work touches. And I have to remember to be a “Mary,” too, to take the time to sit at His feet and rest. Won’t you join me?

For Reflection: In what ways do I turn my service towards Christ? Is my daily work- at the office, in the home, at school, during practice- a gift that I give to God? Do I keep my eyes on my Savior amidst the busyness of my work? Do I do everything for the glory of God? Am I the silent witness of God’s love? How will I take the time this week to sit at Jesus’s feet to listen and rest?

¿Eres "Martha" o "María"? por Kalisa Newton

Para mí, no hay nada como organizar una buena cena. No puedo esperar para sacar los mejores platos, nuestra ecléctica mezcla de platos para servir, la cesta de pan polvoriento, el carrito de utensilios y las servilletas y manteles de tela. Puedo sacar la fuente de pasteles y preparar un postre favorito. ¡Puedo poner lo mejor para nuestros huéspedes! No hay duda al respecto: soy una "Martha". La hospitalidad es lo mío. Con los niños pequeños en casa, no usamos las "cosas bonitas" muy a menudo, por lo que cuando tengo la oportunidad de sacar estas cosas, lo disfruto.

Luego, en medio de todas las tareas de limpieza y preparación, me pongo gruñona. Quiero que otros me ayuden, pero también me preocupa cómo ponen las cosas porque no es como imaginé que se vería. Estoy tan ocupada tratando de hacer que todo se vea bien que no logro enfocar mi atención en los invitados que acaban de llegar. No hay duda al respecto: todavía soy una "Martha".

En el Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos cómo Martha "se preocupó" por la hospitalidad en su hogar a costa de pasar tiempo con su invitado, EL INVITADO. La historia de Martha y María no tiene mucho que ver con trabajar vs no trabajar, servir y no servir. De hecho, nuestro trabajo, ¡nuestro servicio es algo muy bueno! Pero, este Evangelio nos recuerda que el Señor siempre está presente y que cualquier cosa que hagamos debemos servirle. El trabajo que Martha estaba haciendo, su servicio a Jesús y sus discípulos, era bueno y necesario. Lo que perdió de vista fue a Jesús: apartó los ojos de quien estaba sirviendo. María eligió lo mejor porque sus ojos permanecieron sobre Cristo. No tenemos que dejar de trabajar, pero necesitamos recordar para quién trabajamos.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos dice que el trabajo es bueno: *"El trabajo es un deber y un derecho a través del cual los seres humanos colaboran con Dios el Creador. En el trabajo, la persona ejerce y realiza en parte el potencial inscrito en su naturaleza ... El trabajo es para el hombre, no el hombre para el trabajo"* (CCC 2427-2428).

La Teología del Cuerpo de San Juan Pablo II nos dice que el trabajo es bueno: *"Más que el trabajo que hacemos es cómo hacemos nuestro trabajo lo que importa ... [Es] cómo hacemos de cada minuto de nuestro día de trabajo un testigo silencioso del Dios que nos ama. Cuando hacemos todo esto correctamente, nos hacemos un regalo a nosotros mismos"* (de These Beautiful Bones, de Emily Stimpson).

La Biblia nos dice que el trabajo es bueno: *"En el séptimo día, Dios completó el trabajo que había estado haciendo; descansó el séptimo día de todo el trabajo que había emprendido"* (Génesis 2: 2) y *"Hagas lo que hagas, hazlo desde el corazón, como para el Señor y no para los demás"* (Colosenses 3:23).

El trabajo es bueno. Hay dignidad en el trabajo. Nuestra naturaleza humana nos llama a trabajar junto con el Creador para traer bien a este mundo. Es bueno ser una "Martha". Pero he aprendido que debo mantener mis ojos en el invitado al que sirvo, al ver a Jesús en cada alma que toca mi trabajo. Y tengo que recordar ser una "María", también, tomar el tiempo para sentarme a Sus pies y descansar. ¿No te unirás a mí?

Para reflexionar: ¿De qué manera vuelvo mi servicio a Cristo? ¿Mi trabajo diario, en la oficina, en el hogar, en la escuela, durante la práctica, es un regalo que le doy a Dios? ¿Mantengo mis ojos en mi Salvador en medio de la actividad de mi trabajo? ¿Hago todo por la gloria de Dios? ¿Soy el testigo silencioso del amor de Dios? ¿Cómo me tomaré el tiempo esta semana para sentarme a los pies de Jesús para escuchar y descansar?

Applications must be received electronically (preferred) or postmarked by Aug. 31. Grants are awarded during Respect Life Month (October). All grant recipients must provide a follow-up report before May 31, of the following year, to show progress and provide documentation regarding the expenditure of funds.

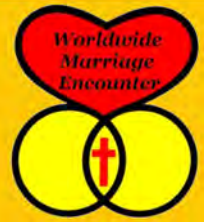

NFP—COOPERATING WITH GOD'S DESIGN FOR MARRIED LOVE

In marriage, serious reasons (e.g., financial, physical, psychological, etc.), may arise causing a husband and wife to limit the size of their family. When that happens, the ever-present temptation today is to use a form of contraception, or to be sterilized. But contraception and sterilization are not the answer—they in fact reject God's gifts. Rather, couples can use authentic family planning methods that are ethical and don't reject God's gifts.

Authentic family planning honors God's design by supporting the love-giving and life-giving nature of sexual intercourse. It promotes generosity, openness to new life, and the value of the child. And, it helps to enrich the marital bond between husband and wife. Authentic family planning builds healthy and holy families. In the world of family planning, only the methods of Natural Family Planning (NFP) can boast of all these characteristics! NFP methods make use of

fertility education. NFP education teaches husband and wife about their fertile time (the wife's ovulation, when an egg is released by her ovary). NFP methods can be used either to attempt a pregnancy or to avoid one. When avoiding, couples abstain from conjugal relations during the fertile time of the wife. No drugs, devices or surgical procedures are used with NFP. Any woman, no matter the variety in her menstrual cycle, can use an NFP method. That is because NFP methods help the wife to recognize her unique signs of fertility which she can observe daily.

PFN: COOPERAR CON DIOS DISEÑO PARA EL AMOR DE LOS CASADOS

En el matrimonio, pueden surgir razones serias (por ejemplo, financieras, físicas, psicológicas, etc.) que hacen que un esposo y una esposa limiten el tamaño de su familia. Cuando eso sucede, la tentación siempre presente hoy es usar una forma de anticoncepción o esterilizarse. Pero la anticoncepción y la esterilización no son la respuesta; de hecho, rechazan los dones de Dios. Más bien, las parejas pueden usar métodos de planificación familiar auténticos que son éticos y no rechazan los regalos de Dios.

La planificación familiar auténtica honra el diseño de Dios al respaldar la naturaleza de dar amor y dar vida a las relaciones sexuales. Promueve la generosidad, la apertura a una nueva vida y el valor del niño. Y, ayuda a enriquecer el vínculo matrimonial entre marido y mujer. La auténtica planificación familiar construye familias sanas y santas. En el mundo de la planificación familiar, solo los métodos de Planificación Familiar Natural (PFN) pueden presumir de todas estas características. Los métodos de PFN hacen uso de la educación en la fertilidad. La educación sobre la PFN les enseña a los esposos acerca de su tiempo fértil (la ovulación de la esposa, cuando un ovario libera un óvulo). Los métodos de PFN se pueden usar para intentar un embarazo o para evitar uno. Al evitar, las parejas se abstienen de las relaciones conyugales durante el período fértil de la esposa. No se utilizan medicamentos, dispositivos o procedimientos quirúrgicos con la PFN. Cualquier mujer, sin importar la variedad en su ciclo menstrual, puede usar un método NFP. Esto se debe a que los métodos de PFN ayudan a la esposa a reconocer sus signos únicos de fertilidad que puede observar diariamente.

Amor natural, tómese el tiempo para aprender, reflexionar y orar acerca del maravilloso plan de Dios para los hombres, las mujeres y el Santo Matrimonio. ¡Responde el llamado a cooperar con el diseño de Dios para el amor conyugal! ¡Amor natural!
