Dear Parishioners of St. Vincent de Paul,

I appreciate the opportunity to provide you an annual financial update along with other information relating to this past year at St. Vincent de Paul. I want you to know that I appreciate what a difficult time this has been for all of us, especially with the temporary suspension of public Masses and all other public gatherings in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. And of course, there is everything connected with COVID-19 itself: the illness, the deaths, the loss of jobs and income, the isolation, the closing of schools, etc. Having said that, I look back on the enormous change we were all faced with in March. Celebrating Mass via Livestream from a small make-shift chapel with an iPhone for you our parishioners. The many of you who adopted new ways to stay connected to Christ through social media and our St. Vincent de Paul eBulletin and website. God has been with us in the midst of this pandemic and we are

thankful that this time has become a source of spiritual growth, our longing and love for the Eucharist, increased time with our family and in prayer, providing support for our neighbors, all helping us to focus on what is most important in our lives.

Come to him, a living stone, rejected by human beings but chosen and precious in the sight of God, and, like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:4-5

We continue to be a growing faith community. This past year, we celebrated 239 baptisms, 266 parishioners received their First Communion and 231 others received the sacrament of Confirmation. In June, we welcomed 38 RCIA participants into the Church. Our various religious education programs catechized over 1,300 of our youth and 388 children attended St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School. The past year marked the second year of the first Catholic High School in Northwest Arkansas, Ozark Catholic Academy with the support and participation of many of our parish families.

Highlighting our year of increased faith, I recall enjoying one of the best Parish Festivals, a memorable Christmas season, Fr. Dennis Chriszt and Mrs. Gretchen Bailey providing a wonderful Parish Mission in March illuminating our core beliefs as Catholic of the real and living presence of Christ in the Eucharist. And too, the challenges and beauty of our Holy Week services.

On December 6, 2019 Bishop Anthony Taylor joined us for the dedication Mass and celebration of our new ministry building. This building, along with the construction of additional parking and a covered drop off area, completed what was started in 2000 to support our vibrant church community. This new ministry building allowed our old office area to return to a Daily Mass Chapel, including the incorporation of the stained glass from the old church building, as well as provide much needed classrooms and ministry meeting rooms.

The total cost of the project was \$5,979,211, which was \$15,722 below the budget approved by the Diocese. Through the commitment of you the parishioner, pledges of \$4,504,603 were made and I am very pleased to communicate that at the end of the fiscal year we have collected 89% of the pledged amount, our outstanding loan balance at the end of the year was \$1,325,488. The financials for this project show a positive campaign. Couple that together with the commitment and hard work of our parishioners this project is a continued success.

We are blessed in the many ways we are able to reach out and serve others throughout our community and the world. Last year, you contributed \$232,103 to support Diocesan and SVDP social outreach programs. Your ongoing support of the Food Pantry and St. Vincent de Paul Society allowed them to provide food and household goods to an average of 494 families per month through the pantry. Additionally, your support of the Black Bag collections allowed the Society to spread \$50,430 to 353 families this past year providing much needed assistance for utilities and other life emergencies. Your continued support to St. Francis of Assisi in Bombardopolis, Haiti is providing for the educational and nutritional needs of over 2,600 children. Our Christmas Love Tree outreach provided gifts, food, and household furnishings to 92 families, warm meals are provided to over 100 homeless persons each month and in partnership with the Oxford Group of Northwest Arkansas, provided a safe, affordable living environment to support individuals in recovery from drug and alcohol addiction. These are only a few examples of the outreach work being done in our church community. Thank you to the many volunteers and ministry teams that lead these efforts, to those who visit the sick and homebound, to those who promote and defend the sanctity of life, and to the many others who share their gifts of time, talents, and financial resources to reach out to others.

Estimados feligreses de San Vicente de Paul, Agradezco la oportunidad de proporcionarle una actualización financiera anual junto con otra información relacionada con el año pasado en San Vicente de Paul. Quiero que sepan que aprecio el momento difícil que ha sido para todos nosotros, especialmente con la suspensión temporal de las Misas públicas y todas las demás reuniones públicas en respuesta a la pandemia de COVID-19. Y, por supuesto, todo lo relacionado con COVID-19: la enfermedad, las muertes, la pérdida de empleos e ingresos, el aislamiento, el cierre de escuelas, etc. Una vez dicho esto, recuerdo el enorme cambio al que todos nos enfrentados en marzo. Celebrando misa a través de Livestream con un teléfono iPhone desde una pequeña capilla improvisada para nuestros feligreses. Muchos de ustedes que adoptaron nuevas formas de mantenerse conectados con Cristo a través de las redes sociales y nuestro boletín electrónico y sitio web de San Vicente de Paul. Dios ha estado con nosotros en medio de esta pandemia y estamos agradecidos de que esta vez se haya

convertido en una fuente de crecimiento espiritual, nuestro anhelo y amor por la Eucaristía, un mayor tiempo con nuestra familia y en oración, brindando apoyo a nuestros vecinos, todos ayudándonos a enfocarnos en lo que es más importante en nuestras vidas.

Vengan a él, una piedra viva, rechazada por los seres humanos pero elegida y preciosa a la vista de Dios, y, como piedras vivas, dejémonos construir como casa espiritual y sacerdocio santo para ofrecer sacrificios espirituales aceptables para Dios por medio de Jesucristo. 1 Pedro 2: 4-5

Seguimos siendo una comunidad de fe en crecimiento. El año pasado, celebramos 239 bautismos, 266 feligreses recibieron su Primera Comunión y otros 231 recibieron el sacramento de la Confirmación. En junio, recibimos a 38 participantes de RICA en la Iglesia. Nuestros diversos programas de educación religiosa catequizaron a más de 1,300 de nuestros jóvenes y 388 niños que asistieron a la Escuela Católica San Vicente de Paul. El año pasado marcó el segundo año de la primera escuela secundaria católica en el noroeste de Arkansas-Ozark Catholic Academy con el apoyo y la participación de muchas de nuestras familias parroquiales.

Destacando nuestro año de mayor fe, recuerdo haber disfrutado de uno de los mejores festivales parroquiales, una memorable temporada navideña, el Padre Dennis Chriszt y la Sra. Gretchen Bailey proporcionaron una maravillosa misión parroquial en marzo, iluminando nuestras creencias centrales como católicos de la presencia real y viva de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Y también, los desafíos y la belleza de nuestros servicios de Semana Santa.

El 6 de diciembre de 2019, el obispo Anthony Taylor se unió con nosotros para la misa de dedicación y la celebración de nuestro nuevo edificio ministerial. Este edificio, junto con la construcción de estacionamiento adicional y un área cubierta para drop off, completó lo que comenzó en 2000 para apoyar a nuestra vibrante comunidad eclesial. Este nuevo edificio ministerial permitió que nuestra antigua área de oficinas volviera a una Capilla de misa diaria, incluida la incorporación de los vitraux del antiguo edificio de la iglesia, así como proporcionar aulas muy necesarias y salas de reuniones ministeriales.

El costo total del proyecto fue de \$ 5,979,211, que fue \$ 15,722 por debajo del presupuesto aprobado por la Diócesis. A través del compromiso de usted, el feligrés, se hicieron promesas de contribuciones de \$ 4,504,603 y me complace comunicarles que al final del año fiscal hemos recaudado el 89% del monto prometido, nuestro saldo pendiente de préstamo al final del año fue de \$ 1,325,488. Las finanzas de este proyecto muestran una campaña positiva. Junto con el compromiso y el arduo trabajo de nuestros feligreses, este proyecto es un éxito continuo.

Además, su apoyo a las colectas de la bolsa negra permitió a la Sociedad repartir \$ 50,430 a 353 familias el año pasado proporcionando asistencia muy necesaria para servicios públicos y otras emergencias de la vida. Su continuo apoyo a San Francisco de Asís en Bombar-dopolis, Haití, está cubriendo las necesidades educativas y nutricionales de más de 2,600 niños. Nuestro programa de Navidad del árbol del amor proporcionó obsequios, alimentos y muebles para el hogar a 92 familias, comidas calientes a más de 100 personas sin hogar cada mes y, en colaboración con el Grupo Oxford del noroeste de Arkansas, proporcionó un entorno de vida seguro y asequible para apoyar a las personas en recuperación de la adicción a las drogas y al alcohol.

Human dignity and the sin of envy in the debate about racism in America

If the Catholic Church has a word to offer society concerning the debate about racism in America, surely it must be a word clarifying the sanctity of human life and reasserting the sacredness of the family. The US Bishops have asserted time and again that racism is a most grave sin against the dignity of the human person. As such, efforts that seek in truth to assess and dispel racism must always go beyond merely functional economic solutions; for the human person is more than an economic functionary, and the value of the family cannot be measured in dollar signs.

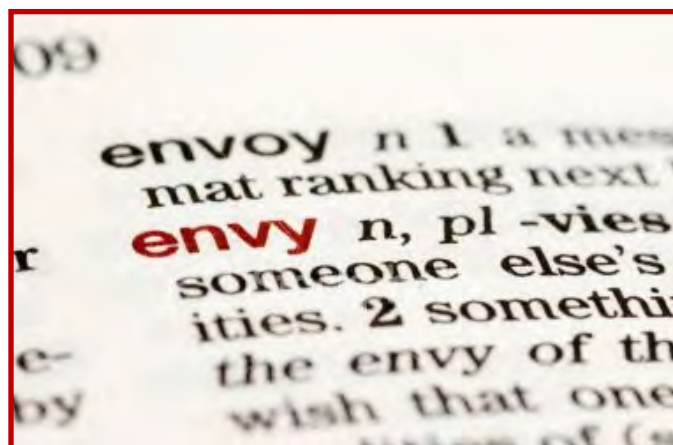
The sin of racism lies in its denial of another's humanity, either in whole or in part. Equally reductionistic of human dignity, from a Catholic perspective, are many of the solutions often advanced to rectify racism. That is to say, very often the debate concerning racism in America revolves exclusively around power, and society divided into 'oppressor' and 'oppressed,' 'us vs. them.' When power alone (defined in political and monetary terms) becomes the fundamental relation and supreme value of society, human dignity of necessity becomes bound up with utility to the system, and the lives of those who are deemed useless are discarded.

It is here that a Catholic contribution can be made to the debate. Concerning the dignity of the human person, the Church teaches in accord with Scripture that each human person has been redeemed by the blood of Christ and that the Holy Spirit is operative within each human heart, either overtly by means of the sacramental life of the Church, or in a more hidden way though prompting each to seek truth and to do the good. The Holy Spirit guides each person towards intimate friendship with the Triune God in this life so that, in the life to come, all might share in the beatific joy of heaven. Although this high calling can be resisted by sin, each human person is nevertheless created and called to share eternally the beatitude of God. The dignity of each person comes not from their utility to a political group or system, but from the Triune God, who creates each human life and through the redemption calls each person to share forever in the eternal beatitude of heaven.

Such a conception of the human person is impossible if power is taken as the most basic relationship between individuals or groups. This is so first because those who have no power whatsoever, such as unborn children, become disposable, and at barbaric rates. The Church must always be a voice for the voiceless, and so must speak for the unborn, and must defend motherhood and fatherhood as goods to be valued precisely because their value cannot be measured in terms of utility to a power structure. The Church must also speak for the poor, and all whom society has deemed expendable.

But secondly, a conception of society as a perpetual power struggle erodes the dignity of the human person because it gives free reign to the sin of envy, the sin that causes sadness at another's good.

Envy is contrary to the sanctity of human life because it perceives the good of another as a threat. Whereas the virtue of charity calls us to rejoice with our neighbor in his good, and most especially in his being called to the blessedness of heaven (1 Jn 3:14), envy banishes this joy and gives rise to a sadness marked by bitterness and resentment. This sin is particularly destructive of a person's moral character when the world is conceptualized ideologically as 'us vs. them,' in which any good gained by the 'other' is a good lost by 'us,' either through force or deception. The human person can no longer be seen as a companion on the way to the blessed vision of God, but only as an obstacle to power, an apparent good that has been chosen in place of God.

Generally speaking, envy passes through three stages. First, envy arises when someone tries to harm or destroy the reputation of another. This can happen through public detraction, in which it becomes permissible to take offence even where no offence was given. Once offended, I become justified in my belief that you are oppressing me, and the power-struggle renews itself, for where there is oppression there is an oppressor who must be silenced.

This defaming and silencing even of the most innocuous leads, if successful, to a dark joy, a kind of rejoicing in the misfortune of another. This is the second stage of envy and comes when the perceived oppressor is finally cast down. The final stage of envy, and envy properly speaking, is hatred of the other's good, especially when efforts to harm or silence the other are not successful. The sadness that envy causes in the human heart eventually becomes a brooding hatred of the other. This is a most dangerous state, because hatred leaves but one option when dealing with the other, and that is destruction.

Just as envy is opposed to the joy bestowed by the virtue of charity, so also discord, which closely follows envy, is opposed to the peace caused by charity (Gal 5:19-23). There can be no real peace within an ideology that understands society as fundamentally a power-struggle. For, in addition to envy, a worldview predicated on power is plagued also by a misconception of the common good. The common good is not like a pizza, where a slice taken by one is a slice lost by another. The good of truth, of justice and peace, the blessings of life and liberty, the good of the family, the freedom to worship God, etc., are not goods that diminish as more people partake in them. They are, however, goods that can be resisted and even destroyed when each person begins to look upon the world as a power-struggle and to set his will against his neighbor, whom he already hates with an envious heart.

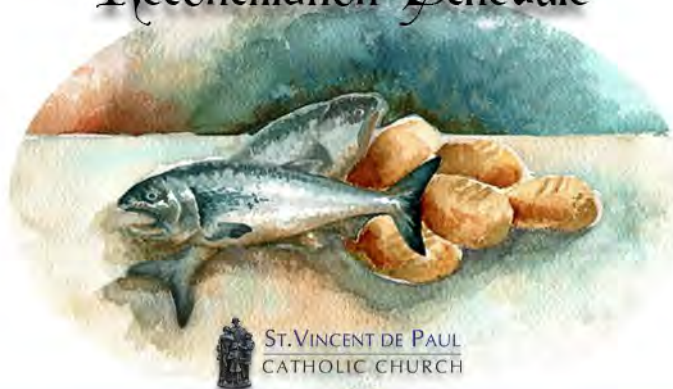
