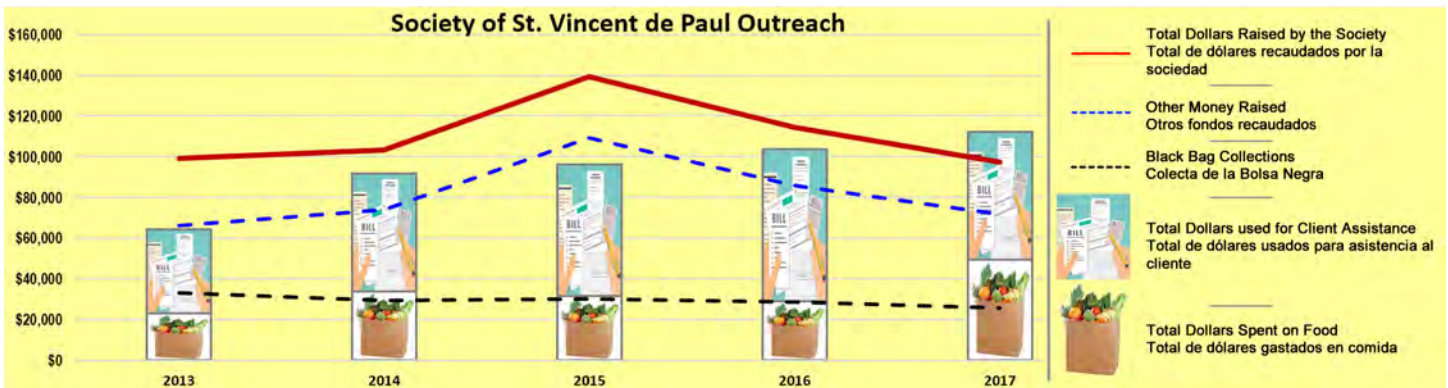

Terminar con la pobreza a través del cambio sistemático

La Conferencia de la Madre Teresa de la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl tiene la bendición de ser apoyada por nuestra Parroquia de San Vicente de Paúl. El año pasado, nuestra sociedad ayudó a 504 personas con sus facturas de servicios públicos y otras en caso de necesidad y nuestra despensa ayudó a un poco más de 43,000 personas con asistencia alimentaria.

Nos conocen como Vicentinos y facilitamos los regalos que las personas de nuestra parroquia y otras personas brindan generosamente. GRACIAS por todo lo que han hecho y lo que continúan haciendo, su impacto para los necesitados ha sido y sigue siendo apreciado y cambia vidas.

Como sucede de vez en cuando, encontramos que nuestras donaciones disponibles y fondos disminuyen en función. Las crecientes necesidades de los pobres en nuestra área y el costo creciente de los alimentos y servicios que brindamos dan cuenta de ello. Debido a estas limitaciones, recientemente hemos tenido que reducir nuestra ayuda a los pobres.

The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was unanimously amended by both the House and the Senate and signed into law by President Ronald Reagan on Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

Prayer brings people together. Prayer builds bridges between opposing persons and even political parties. Prayer reminds us that we are created in God's image and He desires for us to represent Him everywhere we go. Prayer brings UNITY. In 2018, our theme will be Pray for America - UNITY, based upon Ephesians 4:3 which challenges us to mobilize unified public prayer for America, "Making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

Our hope is that individuals, churches, and spiritual leaders in America, will humble ourselves and unify in prevailing prayer for the next great move of God in America. We can come together in clear agreement that this is our greatest need. We can become a visible union, standing together in prayer. We can pray more than ever before, and

practice extraordinary prayer for the next great move of God in America that will catapult the message of the gospel nationally and internationally.

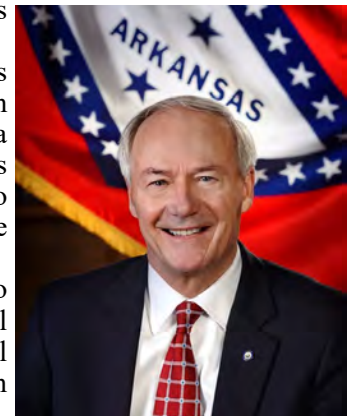

En 1988, la ley fue unánimemente enmendada tanto por la Cámara como por el Senado y aprobada por el presidente Ronald Reagan el jueves 5 de mayo de 1988, designando el primer jueves de mayo como un día de oración nacional.
