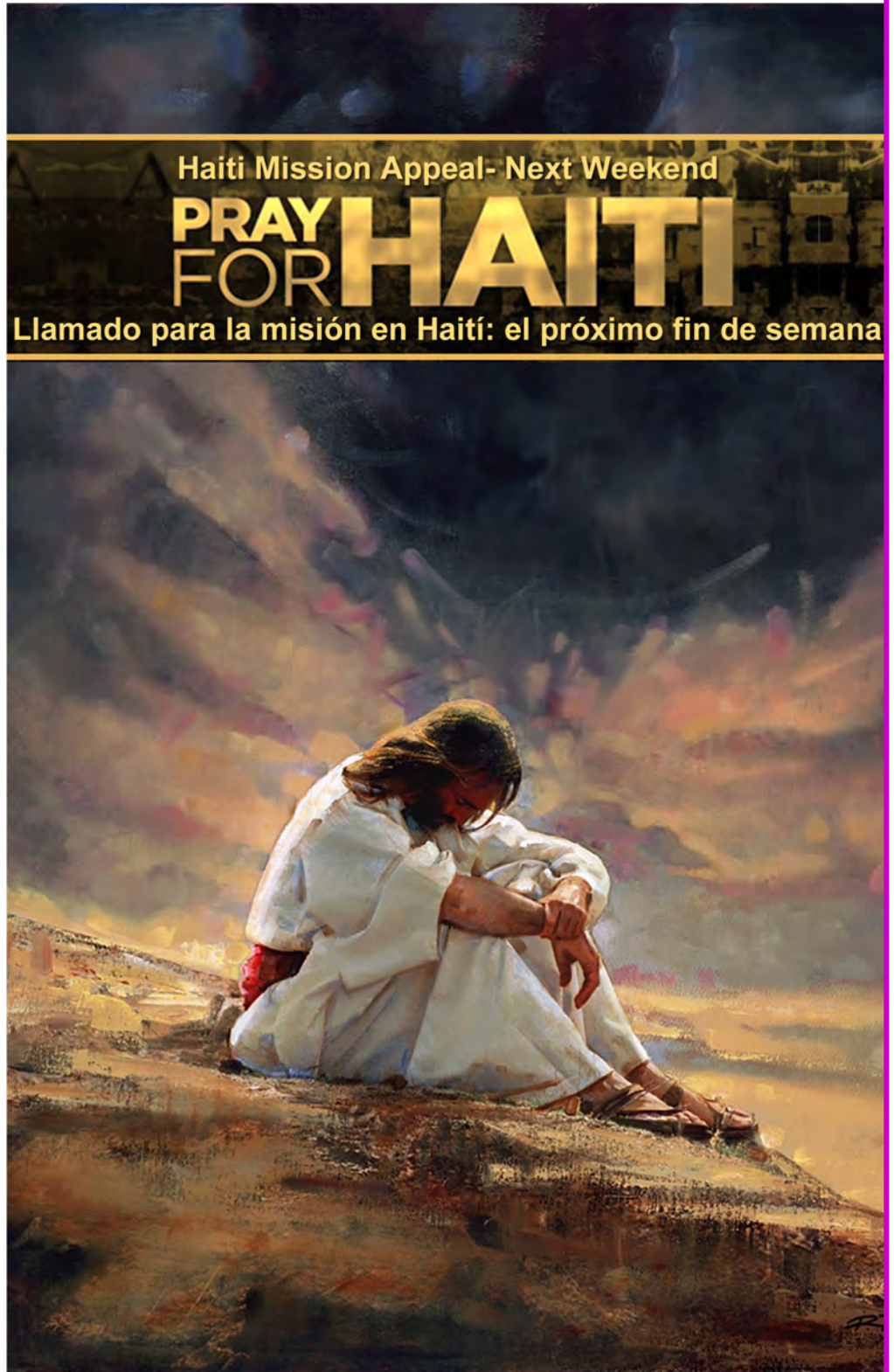

Haiti Mission Appeal- Next Weekend

In May 2018, several of our parishioners had the opportunity to make the 11th SVDP mission trip to St. Francis of Assisi parish community in Bombardopolis, Haiti. Father Adner, Father Rodolphe, teachers, parents and the school children were so appreciative of the efforts of our church community. Hopefully, you can share in their sense of gratitude, hope and love through the Haiti display pictures in the gathering space and from the stories shared by those making the mission trips over the years. The gospel of Jesus Christ is alive in Bombardopolis and our spiritual understanding of what it means to have a preference for the poor is forever deepened.

As you might recall, it was in 2007 the parishioners of SVDP answered Jesus' call by adopting the school children of St. Francis of Assisi parish community. Since that time our parish family has provided the financial support for construction of schools, salaries for teachers, food and school supplies for the children and so much more. Today there are over 2,600 children in grades K-6 attending the 13 mission schools in and surrounding Bombardopolis and 125 children in grades 7-12 attending the high school, constructed in 2010 and expanded in 2013. We celebrated our first graduating class in 2017 and five of our graduates are now enrolled in college.

Thank you for your support as our parish has been blessed in the relationship with our adopted family in Bombardopolis. Please continue to pray the Haiti mission prayer with your family: **Make us worthy, Lord to serve the children of Haiti and all our fellow men throughout the world, who live and die in poverty and hunger. Give them today, through our hands, their daily bread and through our understanding love, give them hope, peace and joy. Amen.**

Llamado para la misión en Haití: el próximo fin de semana

En mayo de 2018, varios de nuestros feligreses tuvieron la oportunidad de realizar el 11° viaje misionero de SVDP a la comunidad parroquial de St. Francis of Assisi en Bombardopolis, Haití. El Padre Adner, el Padre Rodolphe, los maestros, los padres y los niños de la escuela estaban muy agradecidos por los esfuerzos de la comunidad de nuestra iglesia. Puede compartir su sentido de gratitud, esperanza y amor a través de las imágenes de exhibición de Haití en el espacio de reunión y de las historias compartidas por aquellos que realizan los viajes misioneros a lo largo de los años. El evangelio de Jesucristo está vivo en Bombardópolis y nuestra comprensión espiritual de lo que significa tener una preferencia por los pobres se profundiza para siempre.

Como recordarán, fue en 2007 que los feligreses de SVDP respondieron a la llamada de Jesús adoptando a los niños de la escuela de la comunidad parroquial de San Francisco de Asís. Desde entonces, nuestra familia parroquial ha brindado apoyo financiero para la construcción de escuelas, salarios para maestros, alimentos y útiles escolares para los niños y mucho más. Hoy en día, hay más de 2,600 niños en los grados K-6 que asisten a las 13 escuelas misioneras en Bombardopolis y sus alrededores, y 125 niños en los grados 7-12 que asisten a la escuela secundaria, construido en 2010 y ampliado en 2013. Celebramos nuestra primera clase de graduados en 2017 y cinco de nuestros graduados ahora están matriculados en la universidad.

Gracias por su apoyo, ya que nuestra parroquia ha sido bendecida en la relación con nuestra familia adoptada en Bombardopolis. Por favor, continúen orando por la misión de Haití con su familia: **Haznos dignos, Señor, para servir a los niños de Haití y a todos nuestros semejantes en todo el mundo, que viven y mueren en la pobreza y el hambre. ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CATHOLIC CHURCH PASTORAL COUNCIL

The St. Vincent de Paul "Pastoral Council" - previously named the parish council is comprised of numerous parishioners willing to represent the breadth of interests and opportunities spanning our large SVdP community. Pastoral council members include the leaders of our various Commissions: Finance and Administration,

Formation, Liturgy and Worship, Parish Life, and Social Outreach. Pastoral council members also include several members-at-large, plus the leadership of our parish and school staff, and our priests.

These 22 men and women meet quarterly for constructive discussions associated with all aspects of parish life and the mission of the Church, on behalf of SVdP parishioners, while providing consultative support for Msgr. David LeSieur's leadership of our church. The Pastoral Council in collaboration with Msgr. WHY HAITI? - Rob & Becky Brothers

Becky and I joined our parish team's trip to Bombardopolis in May 2013. An opening entry in my trip journal reflected that I hoped "to contribute, to serve, to witness to them, and to reflect God's love for them". In the ensuing five days of the trip, our team experienced limited sleep and electricity; no running water or plumbing; hard work stringing electrical and internet cables; long visits to the schools that we help to sponsor; joyful liturgies; simple but delicious meals; smiles and warm welcomes throughout the town and homes that we visited. My closing journal entry listed four key observations: "1.) The love, the warmth, the openness that each team member showed to the Haitian people was very inspiring; 2.) The sense of accomplishment, despite my personal lack of expertise, working with our team to rewire and string new

cables to prepare for eventual internet service; 3.) The love and spirit with which Fathers Rodolph and Cholet served their people. Though still young men, they have heavy responsibilities, but they wear them lightly and joyfully; 4.) Despite their poverty, natural shyness, and humility, the people of Haiti were mostly a smiling, happy people. They truly are the poorest of the poor, but are thankful to God for what they have". On this trip, I experienced in a most profound way why Jesus assures us that "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35). In making a trip where I was the giver—of my time, my money, my talents—I received far more than I gave. The Social Justice Teachings of our Church reflect Jesus's words in Matthew 25:31-46: we will truly save our souls if with a Christ-like attitude, we "feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, and welcome the stranger"!

¿POR QUÉ HAITÍ? - Rob & Becky Brothers

Becky y yo nos unimos al viaje de nuestro equipo parroquial a Bombardopolis en mayo de 2013. Una entrada de apertura en mi diario de viaje reflejó que esperaba "contribuir, servir, dar testimonio a ellos y reflejar el amor de Dios por ellos". En los siguientes cinco días del viaje, nuestro equipo experimentó falta de sueño y electricidad; no hay agua corriente ni cañerías; trabajo duro, tendido de cables eléctricos y de internet; visitas largas a las escuelas que ayudamos a patrocinar; liturgias alegres; comidas sencillas pero deliciosas; sonrisas y cálidas bienvenidas en toda la ciudad y hogares que visitamos. Mi último registro en el diario incluyó cuatro observaciones claves: "1.) El amor, la calidez, la franqueza que cada miembro del equipo mostró al pueblo haitiano fue muy inspirador; 2.) La sensación de logro, a pesar de mi falta de experiencia personal, trabajando con nuestro equipo para volver a cablear y ensartar nuevos cables para prepararme para un posible servicio de Internet; 3.) El amor y el espíritu con que los padres Rodolph y Cholet sirvieron a su gente. Aunque aún son hombres jóvenes, tienen grandes responsabilidades, pero lo hacen de manera ligera y alegre; 4.) A pesar de su pobreza, timidez natural y humildad, la gente de Haití era en su mayoría personas sonrientes y felices. Realmente son los más pobres de los pobres, pero están agradecidos a Dios por lo que tienen". En este viaje, experimenté de una manera muy profunda por qué Jesús nos asegura que "es mejor dar que recibir" (Hechos 20:35). Al hacer un viaje donde yo era el donante, de mi tiempo, mi dinero, mis talentos, recibí mucho más de lo que di. Las Enseñanzas de Justicia Social de nuestra Iglesia reflejan las palabras de Jesús en Mateo 25: 31-46: realmente salvaremos nuestras almas si con una actitud parecida a la de Cristo, "alimentamos a los hambrientos, damos de beber a los sedientos, vestimos a los desnudos y damos la bienvenida al forastero" "

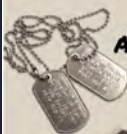

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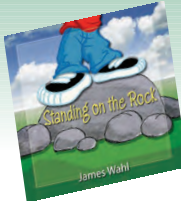
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
