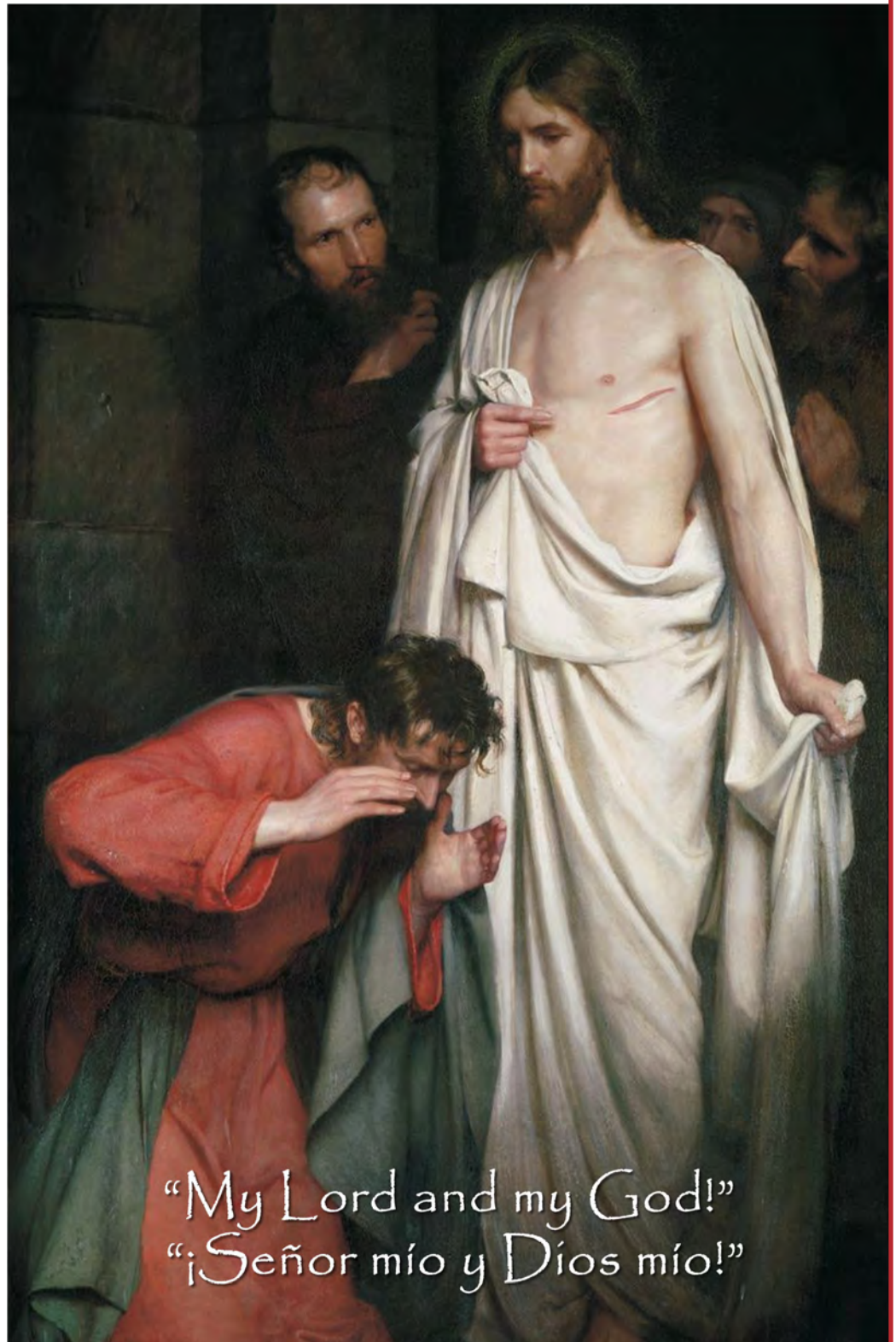

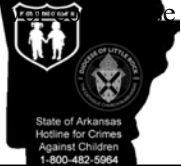

What is the Divine Mercy image? In 1931 on the first Sunday of Lent (February 22), Jesus appeared to an impoverished nun who'd had but 3 years rudimentary education and asked her to document perhaps the most powerful message of Christ since those recorded in the Bible. She was granted a vision of Christ in a white robe with His right hand raised in blessing and His left hand pulling back a fold of his garment at the breast, to reveal His Heart from which radiated two rays, one pale, the other red. He charged her to paint an image according to what she saw with the specific purpose that it be spread throughout the world and venerated by all people.

What is the Divine Mercy message? Our merciful Lord looked upon the trembling young sister with such fullness of tender mercy that she was reduced to weeping under the weight of such unimaginable love, such unbearable compassion. The Lord told Sister Faustina, "Paint an Image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I Trust in You. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world... I went immediately to the chapel and wept a good deal. I said to the Lord, "who will paint You as beautiful as You are?" Then I heard these words: "Not in the beauty of the color, nor of the brush lies the greatness of this image, but in My grace... I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My

own glory..."The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the water which makes souls righteous.

The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls... These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him... By means of this Image I shall be granting many graces to souls; so let every soul have access to it... Let souls who are striving for perfection particularly adore My mercy, because the abundance of graces which I grant them flows from My mercy. I desire that these souls distinguish themselves by boundless trust in My mercy. I myself will attend to the sanctification of such souls. I will provide them with everything they will need to attain sanctity. The graces of My mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is -- trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive. Souls that trust boundlessly are a great comfort to Me, because I pour all the treasures of My graces into them. I rejoice that they ask for much, because it is My desire to give much, very much." [verbatim excerpts from the diary of St Faustina]

Que es la imagen de la Divina misericordia? En 1931 en el primer domingo de pascua, Jesus se le aparecio a una monja muy pobre que solo tenia 3 años de educacion rudimentaria, El le pidio que documentara el mensaje cristiano, quizas mas poderoso desde los documentados en la biblia. Se le consedio una vision de Cristo con una tunica blanca, su mano derecha levantada en bendicion y su mano izquierda halando la tunica de su pecho, para revelar su corazon de donde radiaban dos rayos, uno claro y otro rojo. Le encargo que pintara una imagen de acuerdo con la que abia visto, con el proposito especifico de compartirlo por todo el mundo y ser benedecido por todos.

Cual es el mensaje de la Divina Misericordia? Nuestro señor misericordioso vio a la temblorosa hermana, lleno de ternura y misericordia, tanto que ella fue reducida al llanto, vajo el peso de tan unimaginable amor, de tan inaguantable compacion. El señor le dijo a la hermana Faustina "pinta una imagen de acuerdo con el patron que ves, y con la firma "JESUS EN TI CONFIO" deseo que esta imagen sea benedecida, primero en tu capilla y despues en todo el mundo... Me fui de inmediato a la capilla y llore mucho. Le dije al señor "quien podra pintar tanta hermosura?" Luego oi las palabras "no es en la belleza del color, ni la brocha que pondra la belleza de esta imagen, pero mi gracia..." Prometo que las almas que beneren esta imagen no se perderan, tambien prometo victoria sobre sus enemigos, desde la tierra y especialmente a la hora de su muerte. Yo mismo lo defendere para mi propia gloria..." los dos rayos denotan sangre y agua, que es vida para las almas... Estos dos rayos brotan del mismo centro de mi tierna misericordia, cuando mi corazon agonisante fue avierto por una lanza en la cruz.

Estos rayos protejen las almas de la ira de mi padre. Feliz aquel que se refugia en el, porque la mano de justicia de Dios no lo alcanzara, por medio de esta imagen consedere muchas gracias a las almas; así que deja que todas las almas tengan acceso a ella... Deja que las almas que estan esforzandose particular mente para la perfeccion, adoren mi misericordia, porque la abundancia de las gracias que les consedere, brotan de mi misericordia.

Quiero que estas almas se distingan por la abundancia de su confianza en mi misericordia, yo mismo acudiré a la santificacion de estas almas, les proveere lo que necesitan para obtener la santidad. Las gracias de mi misericordia pueden ser atraídas solamente por un medio. Que es—Confianza, mientras mas el alma confie, mas resivira, las almas que confian en abundancia, son un gran consuelo para mi, porque los llenare de los tesoros de mi gracia, siento jubilo cuando me piden mucho, mucho... (versos extraidos del diario de santa Faustina)

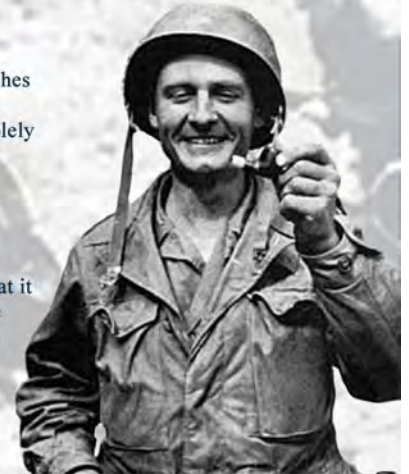
Session 2: Blessed are the Poor in Spirit

The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was unanimously amended by both the House and the Senate and signed into law by President Ronald Reagan on Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

Our theme for the 2019 National Day of Prayer on May 2, 2019 is Love One Another. The theme comes from the words of Jesus in John 13:34, ***"Love one another. Just as I have loved you."***

Our hope is that individuals, churches, and spiritual leaders in America, will humble ourselves and unify in prevailing prayer for the next great move of God in America. We can come together in clear agreement that this is our greatest need. We can become a visible union, standing together in prayer. We can pray more than ever before, and practice extraordinary prayer for the next great move of God in America that will catapult the message of the gospel nationally and internationally.

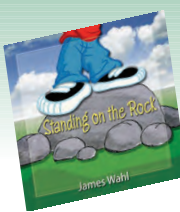
