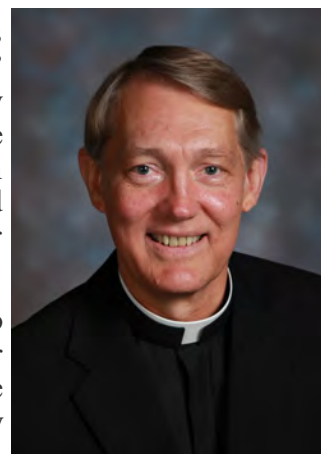
The gospel reading for the Vigil of Christmas is an account of the genealogy of Jesus Christ. As the family tree of most of us, there are some “real characters” in Jesus’ lineage. Some of them are kings. Ahaz, for example, refused to accept the prophecy “the virgin shall be with child and shall bear a son” (Isaiah 7:14). Some of the branches in Jesus’ family tree are women, one a prostitute (Tamar), another an adulteress (Bathsheba), another, a pagan (Ruth). His own mother Mary is mentioned in the genealogy and Matthew will tell us later that Joseph almost divorced her because he did not know the real story behind her pregnancy.

Our tradition tells us that Jesus has two natures, divine and human. The one had no beginning, but the other, through divinely brought about, claimed through his foster father Joseph a human ancestry that was anything but perfect. If we were to trace Jesus’ maternal bloodline, we would find an interesting cross-section of humanity there, too.

Jesus’ human lineage was his entrée into this sinful world - it’s how he got here, albeit through his sinless mother Mary. Matthew’s genealogy tells us that Jesus came to redeem us in his humanity and that his human body with its limitations would allow him to enter into our world, feel what we feel, know what we know and reverse the harmful decision made by the first humans. Jesus is the perfect human and has come to restore our broken humanity. Come, let us adore him this Christmas and every day.

Your priests, Father Rodolphe Balthazar, Father Mike Johns, and I, along with our parish and school staffs, wish all of you a blessed and peaceful Christmas.

La lectura del evangelio para la Vigilia de Navidad es un relato de la genealogía de Jesucristo. Como árbol genealógico de la mayoría de nosotros, hay algunos "personajes reales" en el linaje de Jesús. Algunos de ellos son reyes. Acaz, por ejemplo, se negó a aceptar la profecía "la virgen estará embarazada y dará a luz un hijo" (Isaías 7:14). Algunas de las ramas del árbol genealógico de Jesús son mujeres, una prostituta (Tamar),

otra adúltera (Betsabé), otra pagana (Rut). Su propia madre Maria se menciona en la genealogía y Mateo nos dirá más tarde que Jose casi se divorció de ella porque no sabía la verdadera historia detrás de su embarazo.

Nuestra tradición nos dice que Jesús tiene dos naturalezas, la divina y la humana. El uno no tuvo principio, pero el otro, a través de la creación divina, reclamó a través de su padre adoptivo Jose una ascendencia humana que era todo menos perfecta. Si tuviéramos que rastrear el linaje materno de Jesús, también encontraríamos allí una muestra representativa de la humanidad.

Jesús es el humano perfecto y ha venido a restaurar nuestra humanidad rota. Ven, adoremoslo esta Navidad y todos los días. 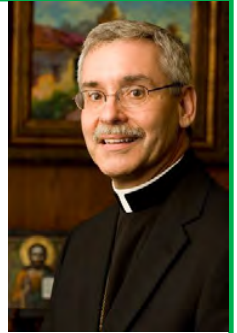

To the parish secretaries serving in the Diocese of Little Rock,

It seems like every year my Christmas message is much the same: On Christmas the light came into the world in the person of Jesus: "All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life, and this life was the light of the human race; the light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it." There is still much darkness in the world, but Christmas reminds us that the light is more powerful than the darkness and the light will prevail!

I find great comfort in this truth first revealed to us on Christmas day 2019 years ago. All of us face adversities in life. Some of these are personal, for instance the loss of loved ones or of a relationship (my own father died this last year and this will be my first Christmas as an "orphan" without either parent) or serious illness (I ask for your prayers for my brother Michael who is struggling with Acute Myeloid Leukemia and for whom I expect to be a stem cell transplant donor). I am aware that many of you have faced serious illness and buried loved ones in 2019 as well. Others areas of darkness are public, for instance abortion, the death penalty, the clergy sexual abuse scandal and our country's refusal to welcome immigrants and refugees. Given the deportations and the threatening rhetoric in the public square, many of our people live in fear and need us to be beacons of hope for them.

As Christmas approaches, I want you to know how grateful I am to you for your service of the Church in your work as parish secretary—you are often the first person people meet when they come into the parish office, so the warm welcome you give them is so important! Your dedication is a light that dispels darkness and brings hope ... and I know that this faithfulness comes at a cost. Many of you do far more than I have the right to expect or demand, and for that too I am grateful.

On Christmas we proclaim that in Jesus the reign of darkness has ended because in him the light that dispels the darkness has come into the world. May that light continue to shine in us ever more brilliantly in the coming year!

Rejoice! Unto us is born a Savior: Christ the Lord!

A las secretarias parroquiales sirviendo en la Diócesis de Little Rock:

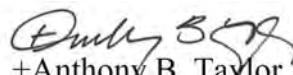
Parece que cada año mi mensaje de Navidad es el mismo: En Navidad la luz llegó al mundo en la persona de Jesús: "Todas las cosas fueron hechas por medio de la Palabra y sin ella no se hizo nada de todo lo que existe. En ella estaba la vida, y la vida era la luz de los hombres. La luz brilla en las tinieblas y las tinieblas no la percibieron". Aún hay mucha tiniebla en el mundo, pero la Navidad nos recuerda que la luz es más poderosa que la oscuridad y ¡la luz prevalecerá!

Encuentro gran consuelo en esta verdad que nos fue revelada por primera vez en la Navidad hace 2019 años. Todos nosotros enfrentamos adversidades en la vida. Algunas son personales, por ejemplo la pérdida de seres queridos o de una relación (mi propio padre falleció este año pasado y esta será mi primera Navidad como un "huérfano" sin ninguno de mis padres) o alguna enfermedad grave (pido sus oraciones por mi hermano Miguel quien está luchando contra la Leucemia Mieloide Aguda y para quien espero ser un donante de médula ósea). Sé que muchos de ustedes han enfrentado enfermedades graves y han enterrado a seres queridos en 2019 de igual manera. Otras áreas de tinieblas son públicas, por ejemplo: el aborto, la pena de muerte, el escándalo de abuso sexual por clérigos y el rechazo de nuestro país para recibir a los inmigrantes y refugiados. Dadas las deportaciones y la retórica amenazante en público, mucha de nuestra gente vive atemorizada y necesita que nosotros seamos faros de esperanza para ellos.

A medida que se acerca la Navidad, quiero que sepan cuán agradecido estoy por su servicio a la Iglesia en su trabajo como secretarias parroquiales—ustedes son a menudo la primera persona que la gente encuentra cuando llega a la oficina parroquial, ¡así que la cálida bienvenida que ustedes brindan es muy importante! Su dedicación es una luz que dispersa las tinieblas y brinda esperanza... y sé que esta fidelidad tiene un costo. Muchos de ustedes hacen más de lo que tengo derecho a esperar o exigir, y por eso también estoy agradecido.

En la Navidad proclamamos que en Jesús el reino de las tinieblas ha terminado porque en Él la luz que dispersa las tinieblas ha llegado al mundo. ¡Que la luz continúe brillando en nosotros cada vez más resplandeciente en el año nuevo!

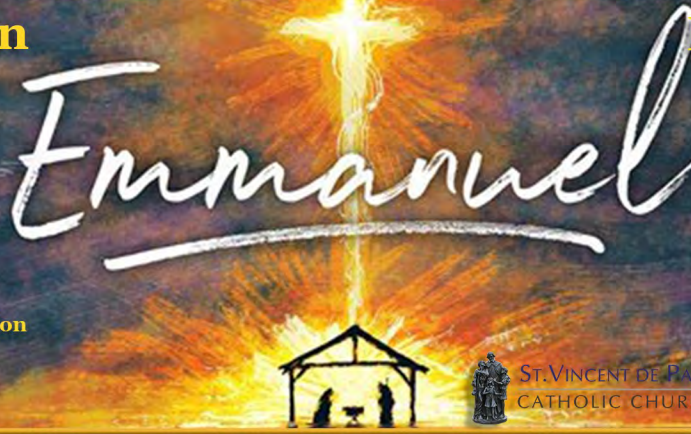

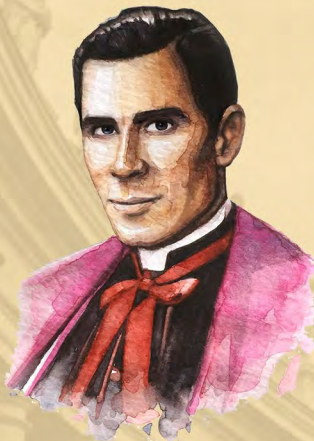

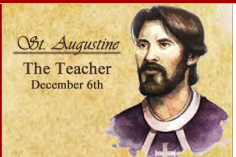
Archbishop Fulton Sheen

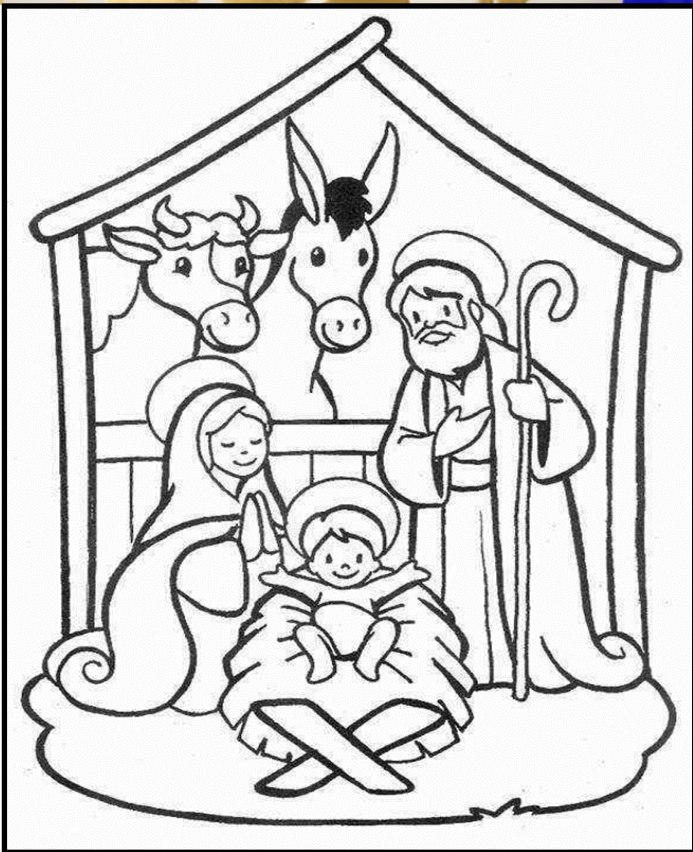

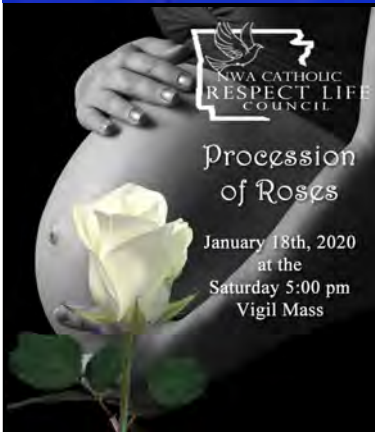

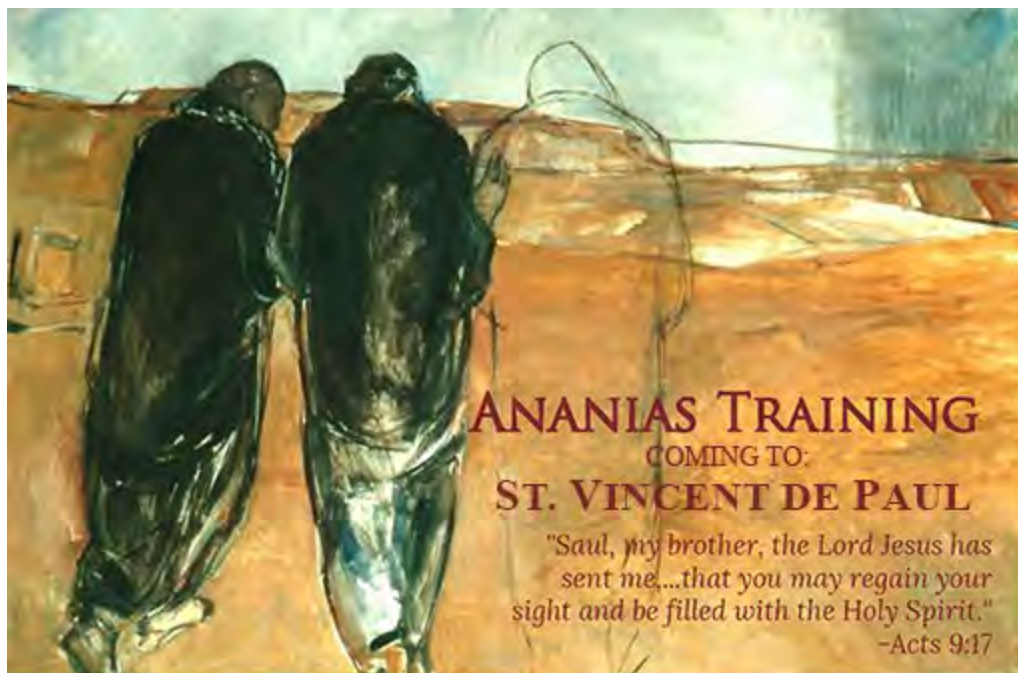
