Those interested in learning about the Catholic faith receive a strong foundation for understanding what Catholicism is all about. Sessions include information about the history of the Church, the Sacraments, and observe the liturgical calendar. Adults are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation. Sessions are also offered in Spanish.

Have You Heard God Calling in the Night?

- Are you interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith?

- Are you unbaptized but recognize a need for more spirituality in your life?
- Are you a baptized Catholic or Protestant but have never received much formal religious education?
- Are you married or related to a Catholic and would like to become a Catholic yourself?

If any of these questions strikes a chord in you, you may find your answers in Christian Initiation. No matter where you find yourself in your faith journey, we invite you to come and see the fullness of the Catholic faith.

What is Christian Initiation?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is preparation for adults who desire conversion to the Catholic Christian way of life after consciously and freely seeking the living God. Over the course of this faith journey, members of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church walk with you, pray with you, and share their faith experiences with you.

RCIA is an answer to God's call to those who are seeking. It is a process that helps people experience a profound change of heart and grow closer to Jesus, our brother and savior. Christian Initiation is a movement of the whole person, in the midst of caring community, to a life lived in the light of God's love.

The Little Rock Scripture Study program is the largest Catholic Bible study in the USA. There are a large number of different studies. Some are focused on a single book of the Bible, for example "The Gospel Of Mark" while others may be more of a thematic type. An example of this type is "Women of the Old Testament". Each study will have a text, usually written by a priest or professor of religious studies and an accompanying Study Guide that gives a list of questions for discussion. All studies are organized into Lessons and there is a short wrap up video for each Lesson.

The studies are aimed at adults (older teens also welcome) who want to increase their knowledge of Sacred Scripture and are conducted in a relaxed atmosphere. There is "homework" (the Study Guide questions) but there are no grades or tests, just good (and often lively) discussions.

We meet Monday evenings at the Patriarch House from 7:00 to 8:30 PM. Our next topic will be the Acts of The Apostles and will start on September 9. We will have registration after all English Masses on August 24 and 25. There is a charge for the course materials, usually \$16. Some scholarship money may be available.

Acts tells the story of the spread of the Gospel and the growth of the early church from its beginnings at Pentecost, following the ascension of Jesus. The Holy Spirit empowers the preaching of Peter, Paul, and the other disciples to take the faith from Jerusalem, to Judea, throughout Samaria and ultimately to the ends of the earth. It records the conversion of Paul and the momentous decision of the early church to welcome Gentiles as well as Jews into the church. Acts is the second volume of the literary work begun in the Gospel According to Luke.

Patriarch House's mission is to help bring the presence of God into the hearts and minds of the people of the parish community. Patriarch House partners with St. Vincent de Paul in bringing Catholic Adult Formation to

parishioners in a small group setting. Patriarch House was enthroned to the Sacred Heart of Jesus led by Msgr. David LeSieur at the dedication. October 14, 2011, the day of dedication, was proclaimed Rogers Patriarch House Day by Mayor Greg Hines. The house has four meeting areas, the largest one comfortably seating 30 people. The smaller areas are used for small-group discussion. The kitchen is kept stocked for hospitality. It has handicap accessibility. 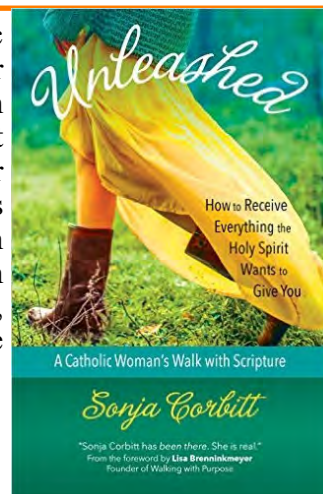

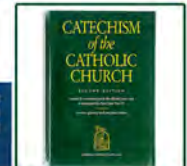

Retreat in Daily Life (RIDL) is the common designation of the 19th Annotation St. Ignatius of Loyola wrote into his Spiritual Exercises. These spiritual exercises evolved through St. Ignatius' own experience as he transformed from a soldier to a servant of our loving God. As you mirror his prayerful journey, following the life, teachings, death and resurrection of Jesus, you will prayerfully encounter a loving God and desire to become all you were created to be.

FORMAT: During the course of 30 weeks--from October through April--retreatants live their commitment to God, to themselves and to their fellow participants by following the steps of this prayer journey. Each retreatant commits to these three experiences:

- Daily private prayer, which includes Scripture, reflection, and journaling.
- Weekly small group meetings in which participants share their prayer experiences with each other. Groups are facilitated by a certified spiritual director.
- Twice monthly individual spiritual direction. Individual 19th annotation retreat experiences will be considered upon request.

FIRST STEPS: If you are interested in RIDL, contact one of the facilitators listed to schedule an initial interview. Interviews will take place July 1 through August 31. The interview process is an opportunity for you to learn more about the retreat, to discern with a facilitator whether or not you are ready to make the retreat at this time, and to begin prayer practices that prepare a person for the retreat experience.

FEES: The fee for the retreat is \$70.00 per month. The stipend for twice-monthly Spiritual Direction is \$20.00 per session.

In keeping with the Rule of St. Benedict governing hospitality, those who have been blessed with more may wish to contribute more, and those who have less give less so that "all may be at peace in the house of God."

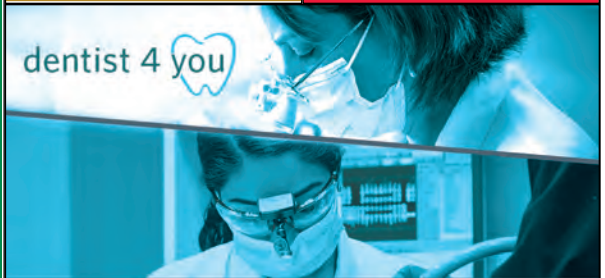
