Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

POPE FRANCIS

When we fail to acknowledge as part of reality the worth of a poor person, a human embryo, a person with disabilities — to offer just a few examples — it becomes difficult to hear the cry of nature itself; everything is connected. Once the human being declares independence from reality and behaves with absolute dominion, the very foundations of our life begin to crumble, for *"instead of carrying out his role as a cooperator with God in the work of creation, man sets himself up in place of God and thus ends up provoking a rebellion on the part of nature"* (Pope John Paul II, Encyclical Letter *Centesimus Annus*, May 1, 1991)....

When the human person is considered as simply one being among others, the product of chance or

physical determinism, then *"our overall sense of responsibility wanes"* (Pope Benedict XVI, Message for the 2010 World Day of Peace)....

Human beings cannot be expected to feel responsibility for the world unless, at the same time, their unique capacities of knowledge, will, freedom, and responsibility are recognized and valued....

Since everything is interrelated, concern for the protection of nature is also incompatible with the justification of abortion. How can we genuinely teach the importance of concern for other vulnerable beings, however troublesome or inconvenient they may be, if we fail to protect a human embryo, even when its presence is uncomfortable and creates difficulties? *"If personal and social sensitivity toward the acceptance of the new life is lost, then other forms of acceptance that are valuable for society also wither away"* (Pope Benedict XVI, Encyclical Letter *Caritas in Veritate*, June 29, 2009).

We need to develop a new synthesis capable of overcoming the false arguments of recent centuries.

The over 56 million abortions since the 1973 decisions of *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton* reflect with heartbreaking magnitude what Pope Francis means by a "throwaway culture." However, we have great trust in God's providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

Jornada de oración por la protección jurídica de los niños no nacidos

PAPA FRANCISCO

Cuando no reconocemos como parte de la realidad el valor de una persona pobre, un embrión humano, una persona con discapacidad, para ofrecer solo algunos ejemplos, se vuelve difícil escuchar el grito de la naturaleza en sí; todo está conectado. Una vez que el ser humano declara su independencia de la realidad y se comporta con dominio absoluto, los mismos cimientos de nuestra vida comienzan a desmoronarse, ya que "en lugar de llevar a cabo su papel de colaborador con Dios en la obra de la creación, el hombre se levanta en lugar de Dios y así termina provocando una rebelión por parte de la naturaleza" (Papa Juan Pablo II, Carta Encíclica *Centesimus Annus*, 1 de mayo de 1991) ...

Cuando se considera que la persona humana es simplemente un ser entre otros, producto del azar o del determinismo físico, entonces "nuestro sentido general de responsabilidad decae" (Papa Benedicto XVI, Mensaje para la Jornada Mundial de la Paz 2010) ...

No se puede esperar que los seres humanos se sientan responsables por el mundo a menos que, al mismo tiempo, sus capacidades únicas de conocimiento, voluntad, libertad y responsabilidad sean reconocidas y valoradas ...

Dado que todo está interrelacionado, la preocupación por la protección de la naturaleza también es incompatible con la justificación del aborto. ¿Cómo podemos enseñar genuinamente la importancia de la preocupación por otros seres vulnerables, por problemáticos o inconvenientes que puedan ser, si no protegemos a un embrión humano, incluso cuando su presencia es incómoda y crea dificultades? "Si se pierde la sensibilidad personal y social hacia la aceptación de la nueva vida, entonces otras formas de aceptación que son valiosas para la sociedad también se debilitan" (Papa Benedicto XVI, Carta Encíclica *Caritas in Veritate*, 29 de junio de 2009).

Los más de 56 millones de abortos desde las decisiones de 1973 de *Roe v. Wade* y *Doe v. Bolton* reflejan con una magnitud desgarradora lo que el Papa Francisco quiere decir con una "cultura desechable". Sin embargo, tenemos gran confianza en la providencia de Dios. Se nos recuerda una y otra vez en las Escrituras que buscamos la ayuda del Señor, y como personas de fe, creemos que nuestras oraciones son escuchadas.

Necesitamos desarrollar una nueva síntesis capaz de superar los argumentos falsos de los últimos siglos.

Has Jesus Been Calling You to Spend Time With Him?

For any relationship to thrive, continue to grow, and deepen, we must share ourselves through time spent together and through conversation. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Vincent de Paul is your opportunity, on a daily basis, to be with Jesus. He invites you to spend time with him. He waits for you in the church, and looks forward to spending time with you. He waits to hear all you have to tell Him, and all that you have to ask of Him. He waits for you to open your heart to hear what He has to say to you.

An hour in adoration is your personal time with Jesus to cultivate a true relationship with Him. Sit quietly, or have a silent heart to heart conversation – Be present to Jesus as He is Present to you. Adore him – show him love and Gratitude. Consider his humility as he avails himself to you.

In adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, we answer the call from the Lord to adore His Real Presence in the Eucharist. We join a line of people that stretches through the centuries, from the stable in Bethlehem in the company of the Angels, shepherds, and Magi – through all of history to this day. This mystical union of ages and adoring souls has sustained the very heart of the Church.

Adoration is the giving of your time to the Lord, and for such a commitment, graces and blessings will be bestowed on you and your loved ones – in this life and the next. Adoration will also strengthen our parish family, and help us to stay focused on the important events in our journey through life.

I am new to adoration and am finding it somewhat awkward to fill the hour without becoming distracted. What can I do to remain focused? To help regain your focus when you find your mind drifting away from your conversation with or contemplation of Jesus you can:

- † Pray a rosary or Chaplet or the Liturgy of the Hours.
- † Read and pray about Scripture or spiritual reading.
- † Pray for: The intentions of the Pope, The Pope, The Church, Our Priests, our Parish, our Youth and Youth Programs, Vocations, The Right to Life, The Family - and any concerns you have.

Recognizing a need to call the faithful to support missionary work among African American and Native American Catholics, the U.S. Catholic bishops established the Commission for the Catholic Missions in 1884 to administer a national collection—the first of its kind in the United States—to support missionary work.

Ever since the first Collection in 1887, the Commission has administered the yearly, national Black and Indian Mission Collection. The generosity of the good People of God allows the Commission to give helpful grants to dioceses across the country to operate schools, parishes, and other missionary services that build the Body of Christ in Native American, Alaska Native, and Black Catholic communities. 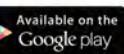

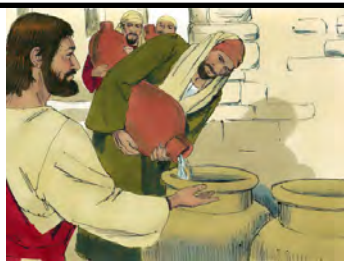

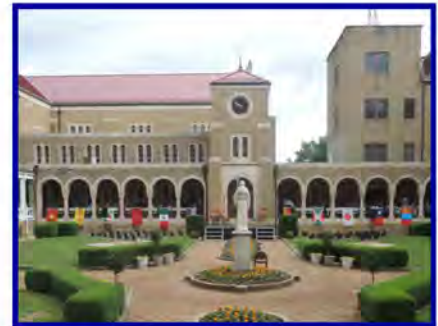
