The debate rages on: is it “Happy Holidays” or “Season’s Greetings” or “Merry Christmas”? I really don’t like any of these wishes, even though they are meant to convey positive feelings. I’m all for expressions of positive feelings, but only when they’re sincere and not trying to be politically correct. By now we’re all aware of the hesitance of advertisers to use the word “Christmas”; we all know that public displays of Nativity scenes are off limits on the lawns of government buildings. Even city parades in December are being renamed “winter parades” or “holiday parades”. We don’t want to offend anyone.

So what’s wrong with saying “Merry Christmas”? Nothing, really, except that the word “merry” seems to be a bit shallow as a sentiment for an event as important as the Incarnation of the Son of God. In this context the word “happy” is just as deficient. I prefer the word “joyous”, a word with deeper resonances than those we normally use with “holidays” or “Christmas”. Jesus came to us “that our joy might be complete” (John 15: 11).

It’s alright if government buildings don’t display the crèche and if stores don’t want to use the word Christmas in their ads; we’ll still attend a holiday parade. But it’s up to us who believe in the real Reason for the Season to express our joy and our faith when we say “Have a joyous Christmas” to friends, loved ones and strangers. It’s the Good News and we Christians are supposed to spread it.

El debate continúa: ¿se dice “Felices fiestas” o “Saludos festivos” o “Feliz Navidad”? Realmente no me gusta ninguno de estos deseos, a pesar de que están destinados a transmitir sentimientos positivos. Estoy a favor de las expresiones de sentimientos positivos, pero solo cuando son sinceros y no tratan de ser políticamente correctos. A estas alturas, todos somos conscientes de las dudas de los anunciantes en utilizar la palabra “Navidad”; todos sabemos que las exhibiciones públicas de belenes están prohibidas en los jardines de los edificios gubernamentales. Incluso los desfiles de la ciudad en diciembre se están denominando “desfiles de invierno” o “desfiles de vacaciones”. No queremos ofender a nadie.

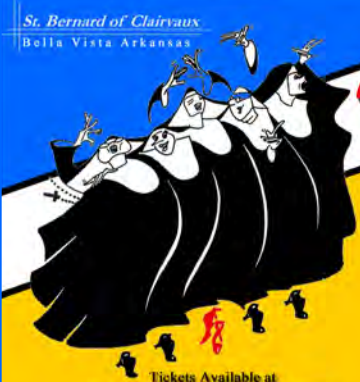
Entonces, ¿qué hay de malo en decir “Feliz Navidad”? Nada, en realidad, excepto que la palabra “alegre” parece ser un poco superficial como sentimiento para un evento tan importante como la Encarnación del Hijo de Dios. En este contexto, la palabra “feliz” es igualmente deficiente. Prefiero la palabra “alegre”, una palabra con resonancias más profundas que las que usamos normalmente con “vacaciones” o “Navidad”. Jesús vino a nosotros “para que nuestra alegría sea completa” (Juan 15: 11).

Está bien si los edificios del gobierno no muestran el pesebre y si las tiendas no quieren usar la palabra Navidad en sus anuncios; Todavía asistiremos a un desfile de vacaciones. Pero depende de nosotros, quienes creemos en la verdadera razón de la temporada, expresar nuestra alegría y nuestra fe cuando decimos “Feliz Navidad” a amigos, seres queridos y extraños. Son las buenas nuevas y los cristianos se supone que debemos difundirlas.

Parish School Closing...

Snow Days and Closings: In case inclement weather necessitates the closing of school, SVdP School will usually abide by the decision made for Rogers Public Schools but may, on occasion, do otherwise. **Please listen to the news or check *parentsweb* for any postings from the principal. Whenever possible, the principal will send a mass communication phone announcement through *parentsweb* about any closure. Do not call the school or the church office.** The Diocese has allotted five Digital Days for school work requirements. Digital Days involve at-home assignments, some of which will require Internet capability, to keep students on schedule with curriculum and education goals. Estimated completion times for Digital Day assignments will be age appropriate. More details will be disseminated as needed.

St Vincent de Paul Church Closing...

When Rogers Public Schools are cancelled on a Monday or Wednesday, our Religious Education programs (Kindergarten through Adult), will be cancelled. Mass will be canceled ONLY if the communication resources listed below specifically says as such. During inclement weather, announcement through the SVdP App & website and the SVdP Facebook pages will be posted. In addition, television channels 40/29, KFSM & KNWA will have information posted as well.

Please use extreme caution when attending Mass or your Adoration hour especially when the campus is closed, as sidewalks and parking lots may be icy.

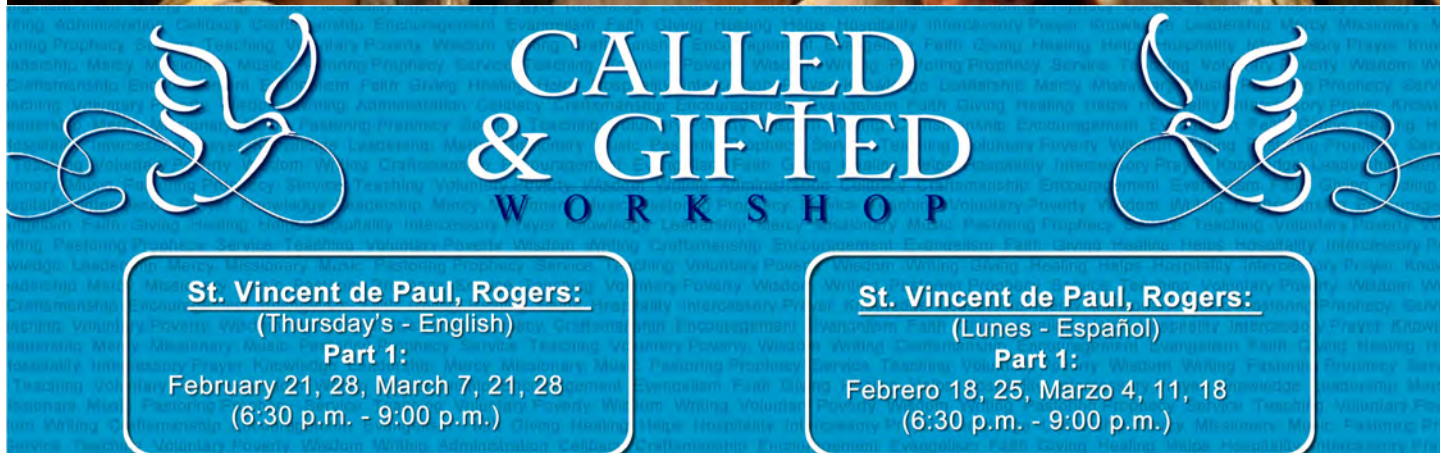

Called and Gifted Workshop

Called and Gifted workshops are designed to help adult Catholics discover their own charisms. The curriculum focuses on getting a better understanding of what the charisms are and building a foundation for participants to discern their charisms and how they can be used in God's plan for their life.

Father Erik Pohlmeier, diocesan director of faith formation explains; "Charisms are different than just talents. We would say that talents come from God, but talents could be used selfishly as well. Like I could have a talent that I just ignore God for and use however I want. Charisms are more specifically tied to the fruit of the Holy Spirit, and so they would say a charism can't bear fruit in a selfish way because it depends on the work of the Holy Spirit, not just on your ability. While charisms are about how they affect the person, it's also about affecting those around them who benefit from it. If we're humble we don't acknowledge that people benefit from what we do, we downplay that. So part of discerning is recognizing the good that comes from it is the fruit that comes from God and not to have a false humility about it."

Kathleen Blessing, a spiritual director and parishioner at St. Joseph Church in Fayetteville, has been leading the Called and Gifted program for the past year. "It's a discernment process to help people come to know how the Lord speaks to them and what gifts they received at baptism and confirmation. It's teaching you to be still, to listen, to have prayer time," she said. "... It's his divine plan for you. I've had people say, 'Oh, my gosh for the first time in my life I'm beginning to understand how God is using me.'"

To discover your charism is to discover what will energize your service in the Church and in the world and bear fruit according to God's designs. These workshops are being offered in English and Spanish.

Taller ser llamado y dotado "called and gifted"

Los talleres de Called and gifted están diseñados para ayudar a los católicos adultos a descubrir sus propios carismas. El plan de estudios se enfoca en obtener una mejor comprensión de qué son los carismas y en construir una base para que los participantes puedan discernir sus carismas y cómo pueden ser utilizados en el plan de Dios para su vida.

El padre Erik Pohlmeier, director diocesano de formación en la fe explica; "Los carismas son diferentes a los talentos. Diríamos que los talentos provienen de Dios, pero los talentos también se pueden usar de manera egoísta. Como si pudiera tener un talento por el que simplemente ignoro a Dios y lo uso como quiero. Los carismas están más específicamente ligados al fruto del Espíritu Santo, por lo que dirían que un carisma no puede dar frutos de manera egoísta porque depende de la obra del Espíritu Santo, no solo de su capacidad. Si bien los carismas se refieren a cómo afectan a la persona, también se trata de afectar a quienes la rodean y se benefician de ella. Si somos humildes, no reconocemos que las personas se benefician de lo que hacemos, minimizamos eso. Por lo tanto, parte del discernimiento es reconocer que el bien que proviene es el fruto que proviene de Dios y no tener una falsa humildad al respecto".

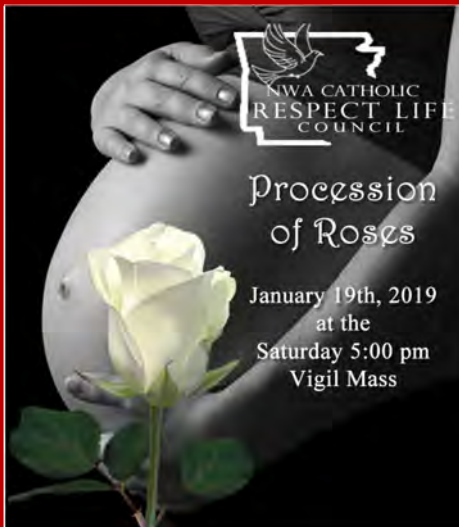
