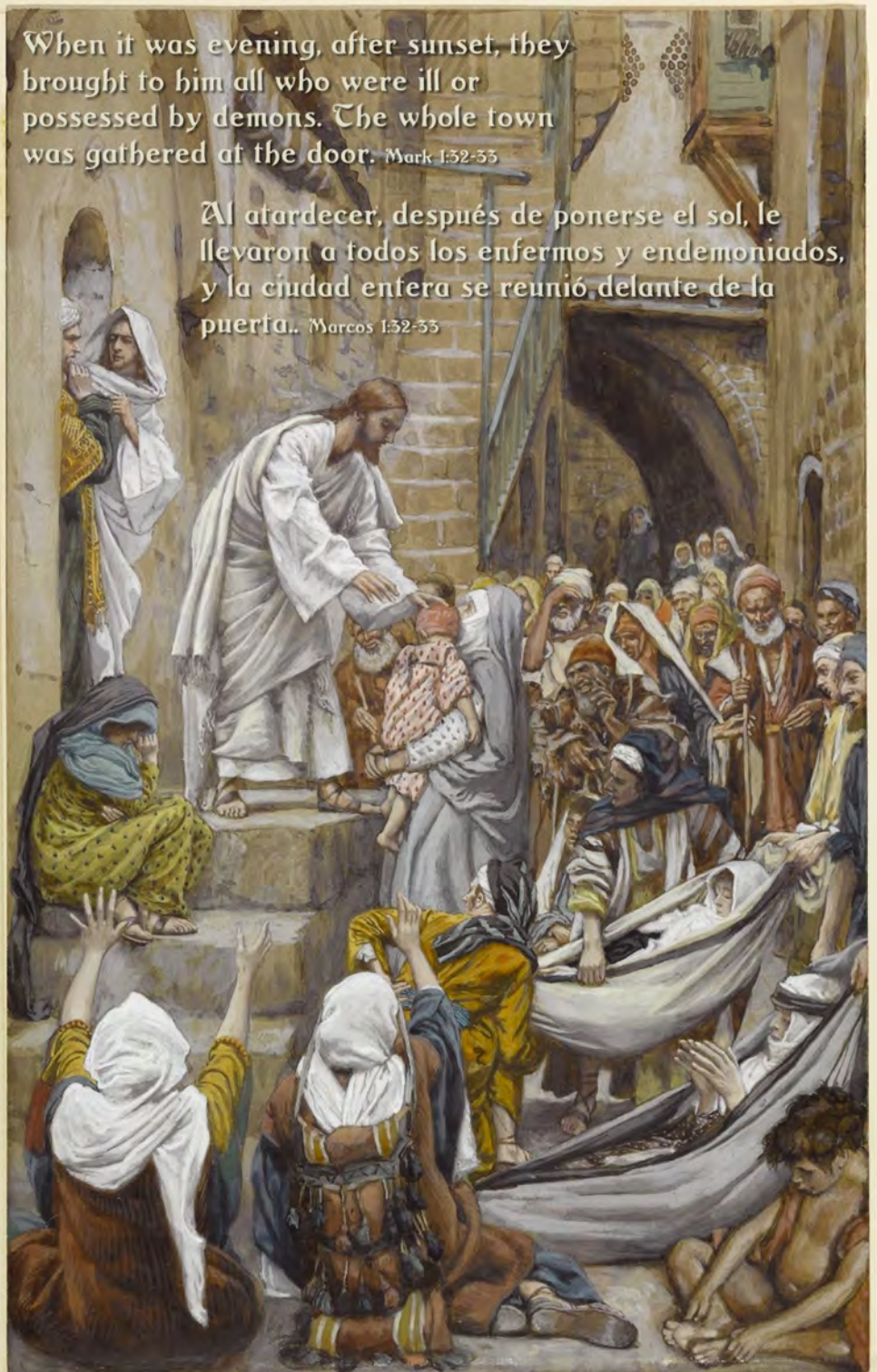

ABOUT FATHER PHILLIP, FJ



Father Phillip Scott is the Founder of Family of Jesus religious community of the Roman Catholic Church, an international retreat director, conference speaker and author who is known for his work around the issue of forgiveness. The mission of Father Phillip and Family of Jesus is living their baptismal calling to follow Jesus Christ and be His instruments of healing for the individual domestic family, the broader family, the Church and society. Family of Jesus is comprised of priests, brothers and sisters dedicated to Christ, His Church and are bound by vows of obedience, chastity, poverty and martyrdom. Family of Jesus was founded by Father Philip in 1998 under the auspices of Bishop Robert Lynch of the Diocese of St. Petersburg in Tampa, Florida. Since January 10, 2003, Family of Jesus has served as missionaries to the poor under Bishop David Martínez De Aguirre Guinea, O.P. Of Vicar Apostolic of Puerto Maldonado, Peru

More background on Fr. Philip:

"In 1980, Philip Scott experienced the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit, leading him back to the belief in Christ that he had abandoned as a teenager." Born in Lima, Peru, this priest was five years old when his family moved to the United States. But as an adult priest visiting Peru, he was kidnapped by a highly organized group that planned to execute him. Father Scott tried to give them his car keys, but the armed men responded, "We want you." Two hours later, the priest felt himself taken down inside of the Holy Trinity during a 20-minute spiritual experience. He saw light brighter than the sun and heard God say, "What separates time and eternity is a thread." He felt deep intimacy with God and felt that he was truly home, where he had always longed to be. He felt "giddy" to know he would be in God's arms forever.

Más antecedentes sobre el padre. Philip:

"En 1980, Philip Scott experimentó el poder y los dones del Espíritu Santo, lo que lo llevó a la creencia en Cristo que había abandonado cuando era adolescente". Nacido en Lima, Perú, este sacerdote tenía cinco años cuando su familia se mudó a los Estados Unidos. Pero como un sacerdote adulto que visitaba Perú, fue secuestrado por un grupo altamente organizado que planeaba ejecutarlo. El padre Scott intentó darles las llaves de su auto, pero los hombres armados respondieron, "Te queremos". Dos horas más tarde, el sacerdote se sintió llevado dentro de la Santísima Trinidad durante una experiencia espiritual de 20 minutos. Vio luz más brillante que el sol y escuchó a Dios decir: "Lo que separa el tiempo y la eternidad es un hilo". Sintió una profunda intimidad con Dios y sintió que realmente estaba en casa, donde siempre había deseado estar. Se sintió "mareado" al saber que estaría en los brazos de Dios para siempre.

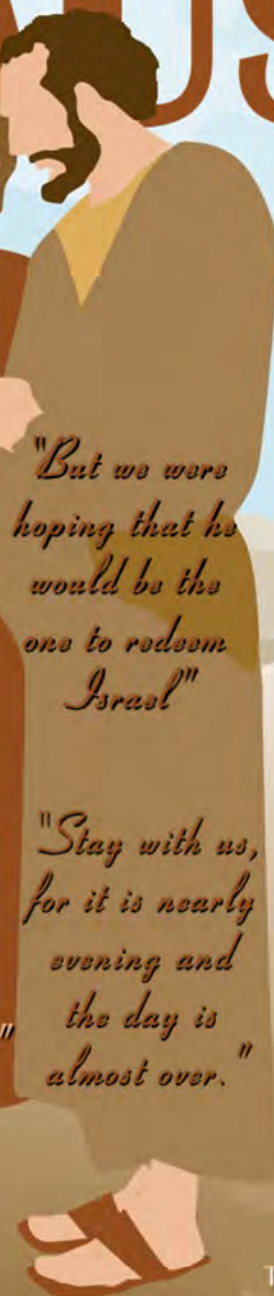
